creativity is yours to explore!

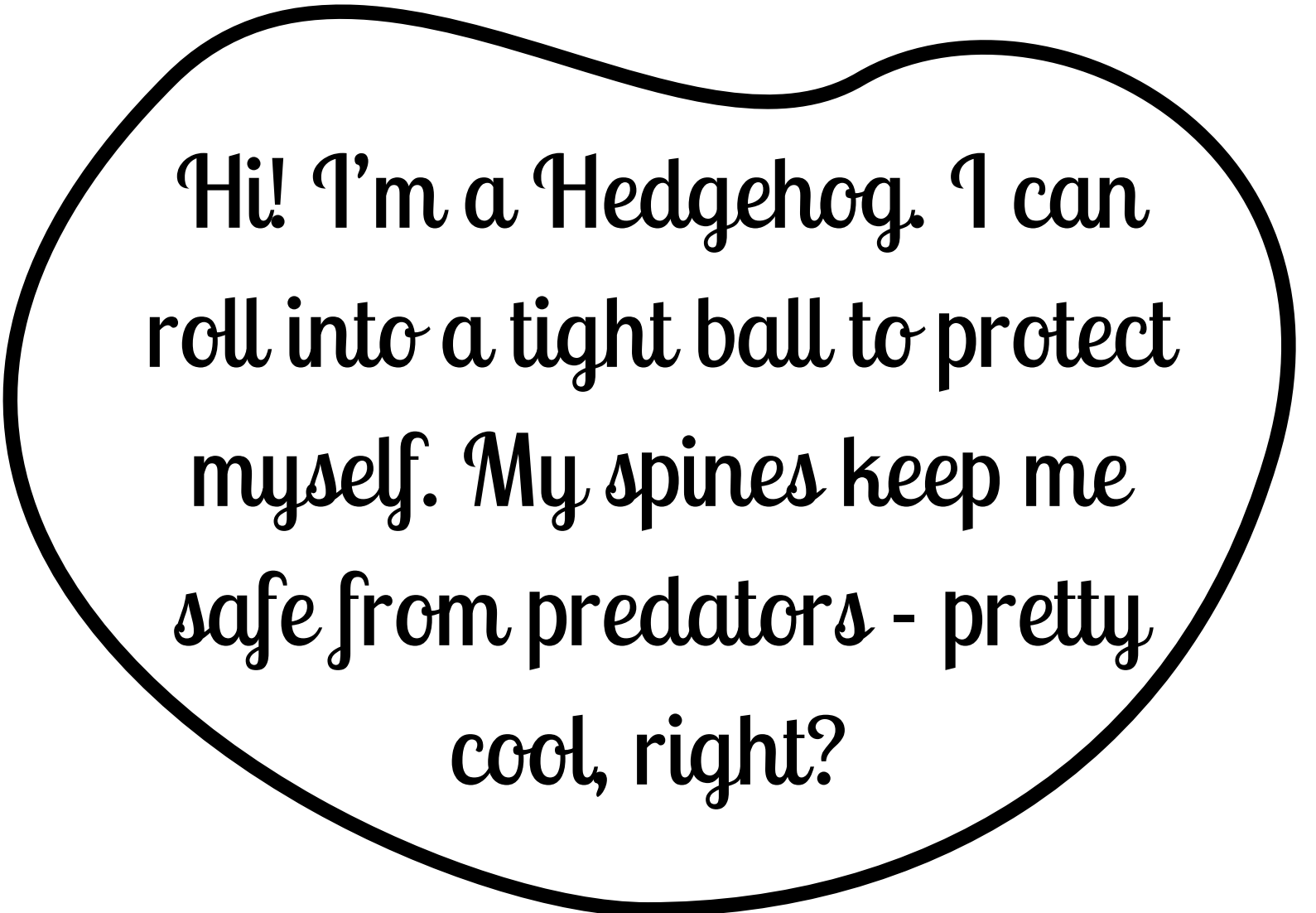

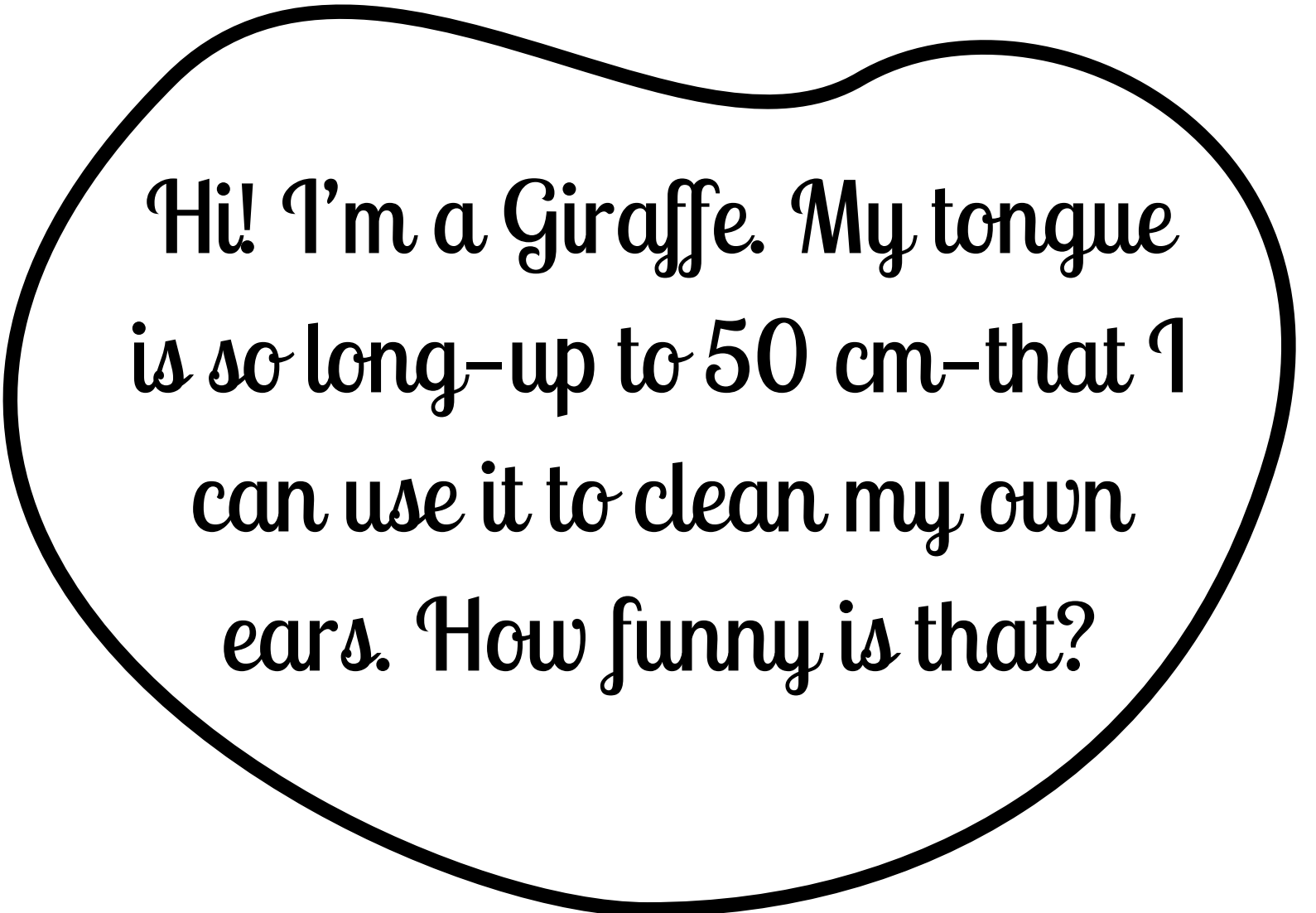
Hello! I'm a Fawn. I have

cool, right?





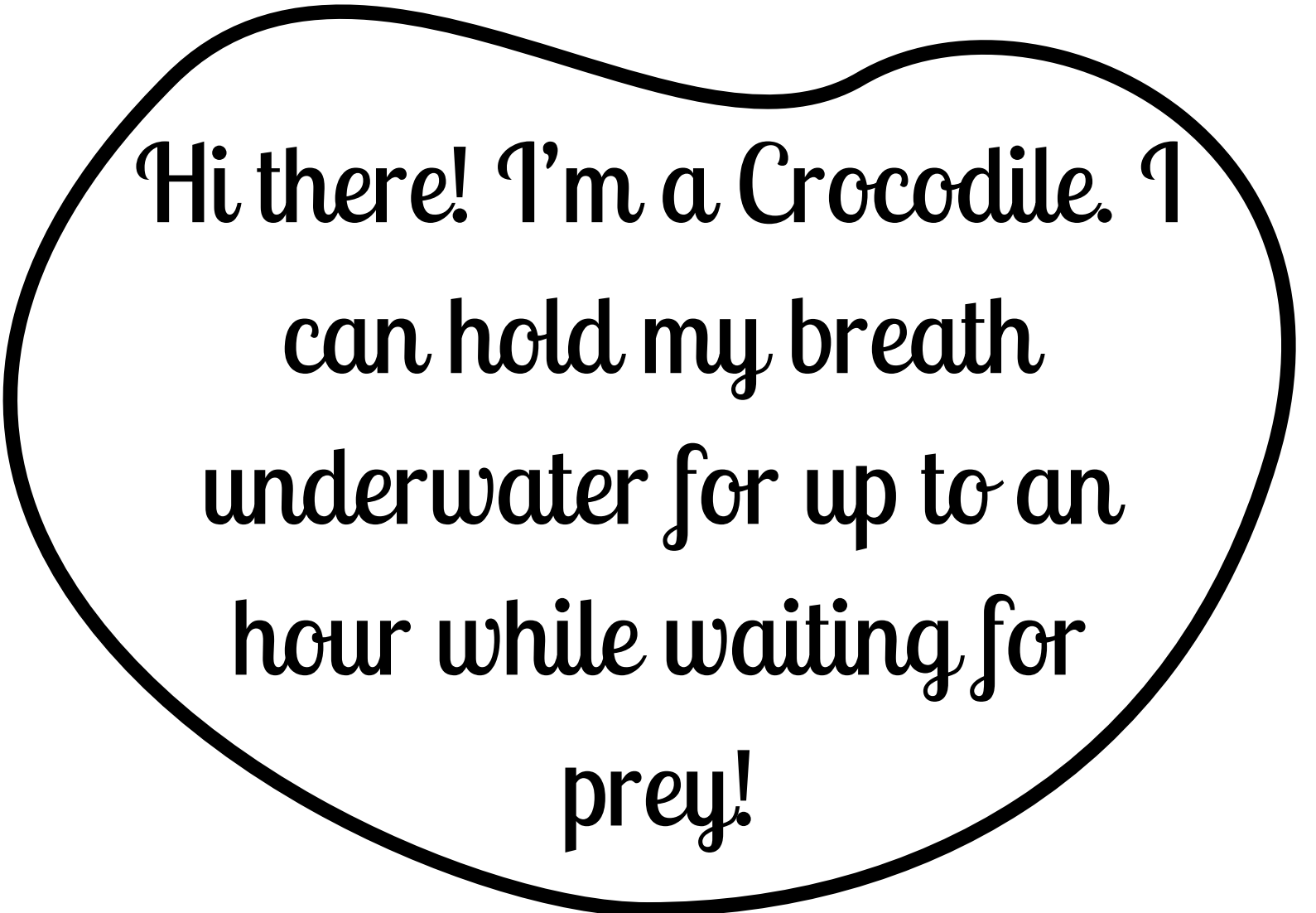
Hi! I'm a Giraffe. My tongue

ears. How funny is that?





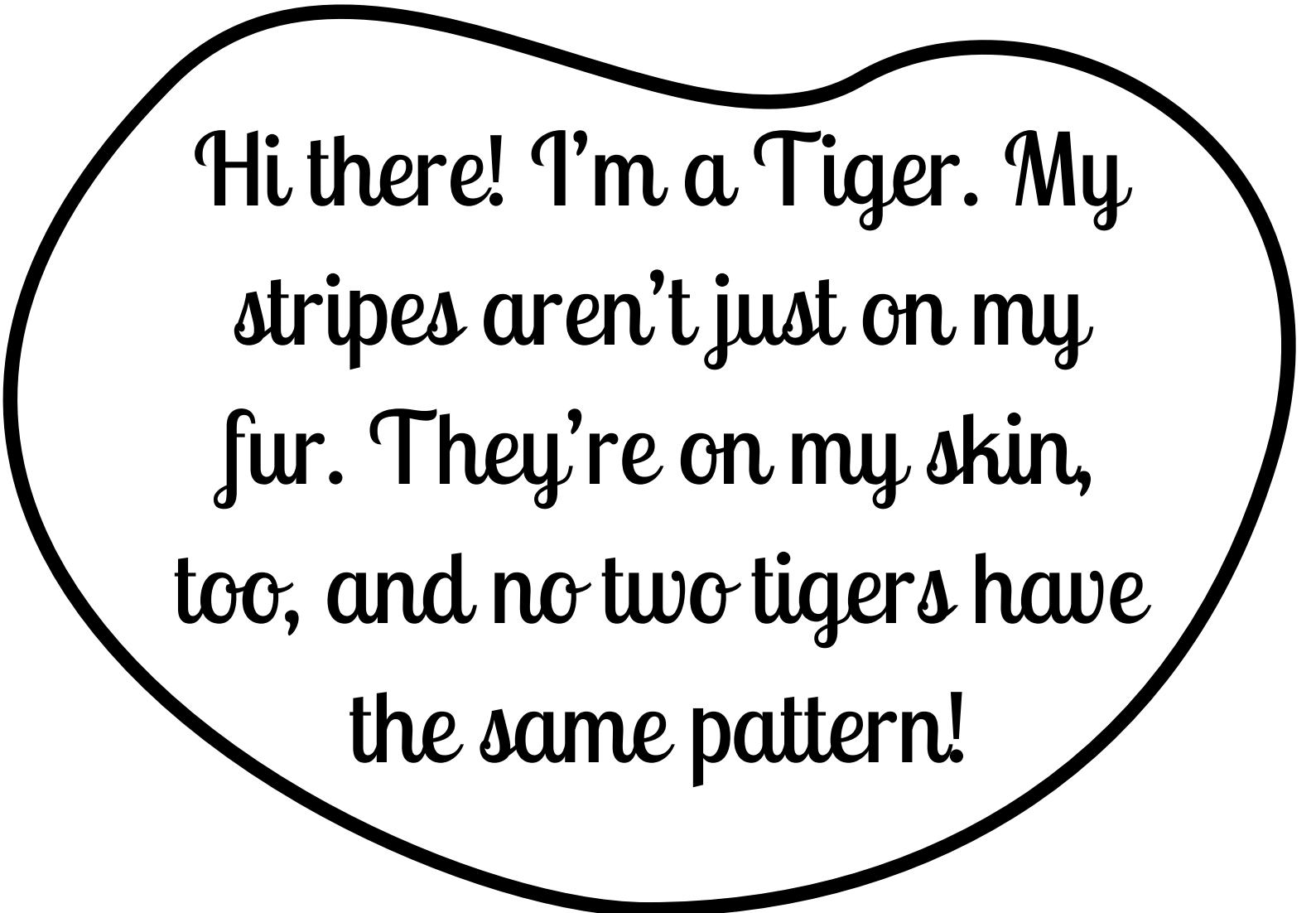
Hi! I'm a Rabbit. My teeth

prey!





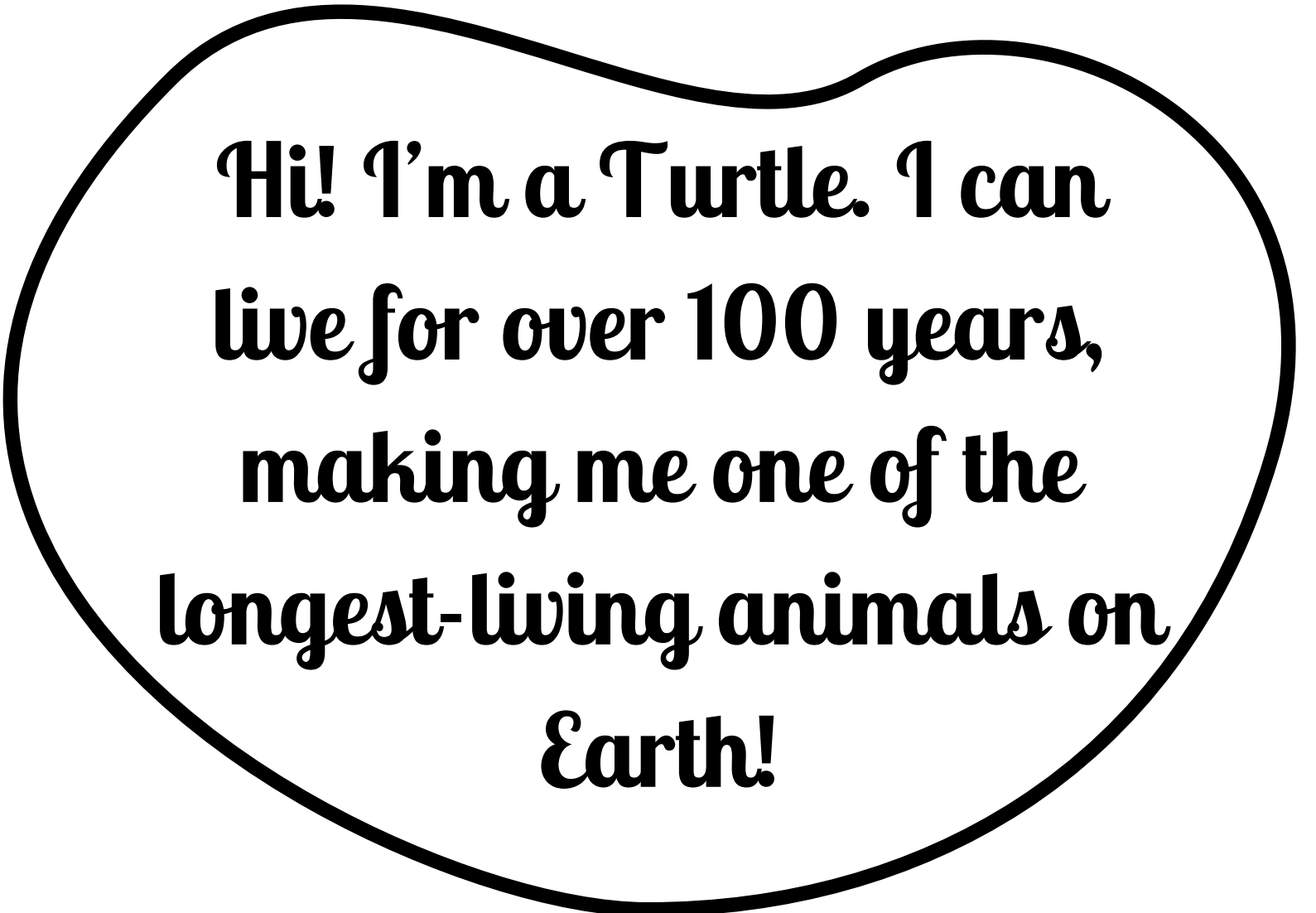
Hi there! I'm a Tiger. My stripes aren't just on my fur. They're on my skin, too, and no two tigers have the same pattern!





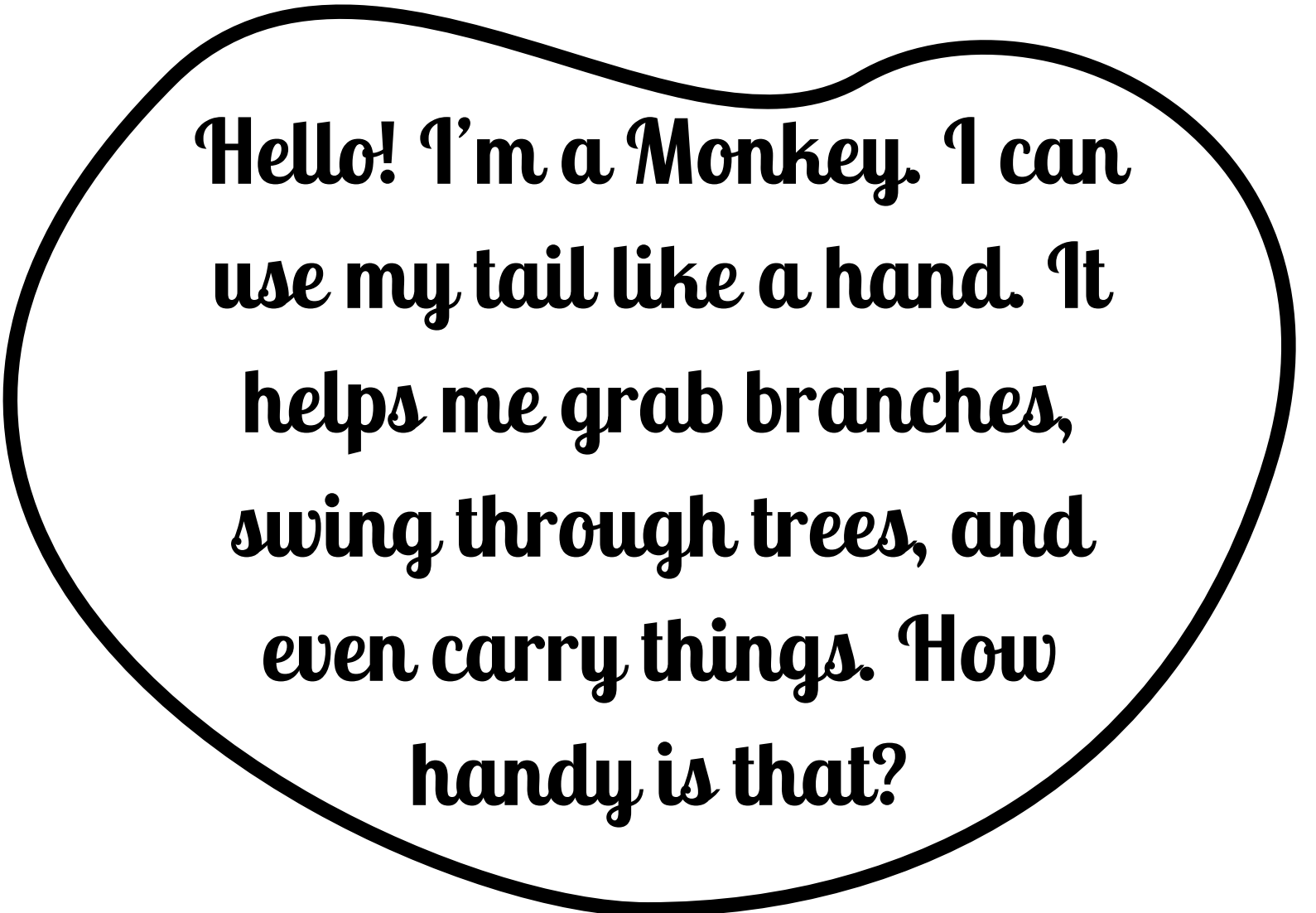
**Hi! I'm a Zebra. My stripes

clever, huh?**





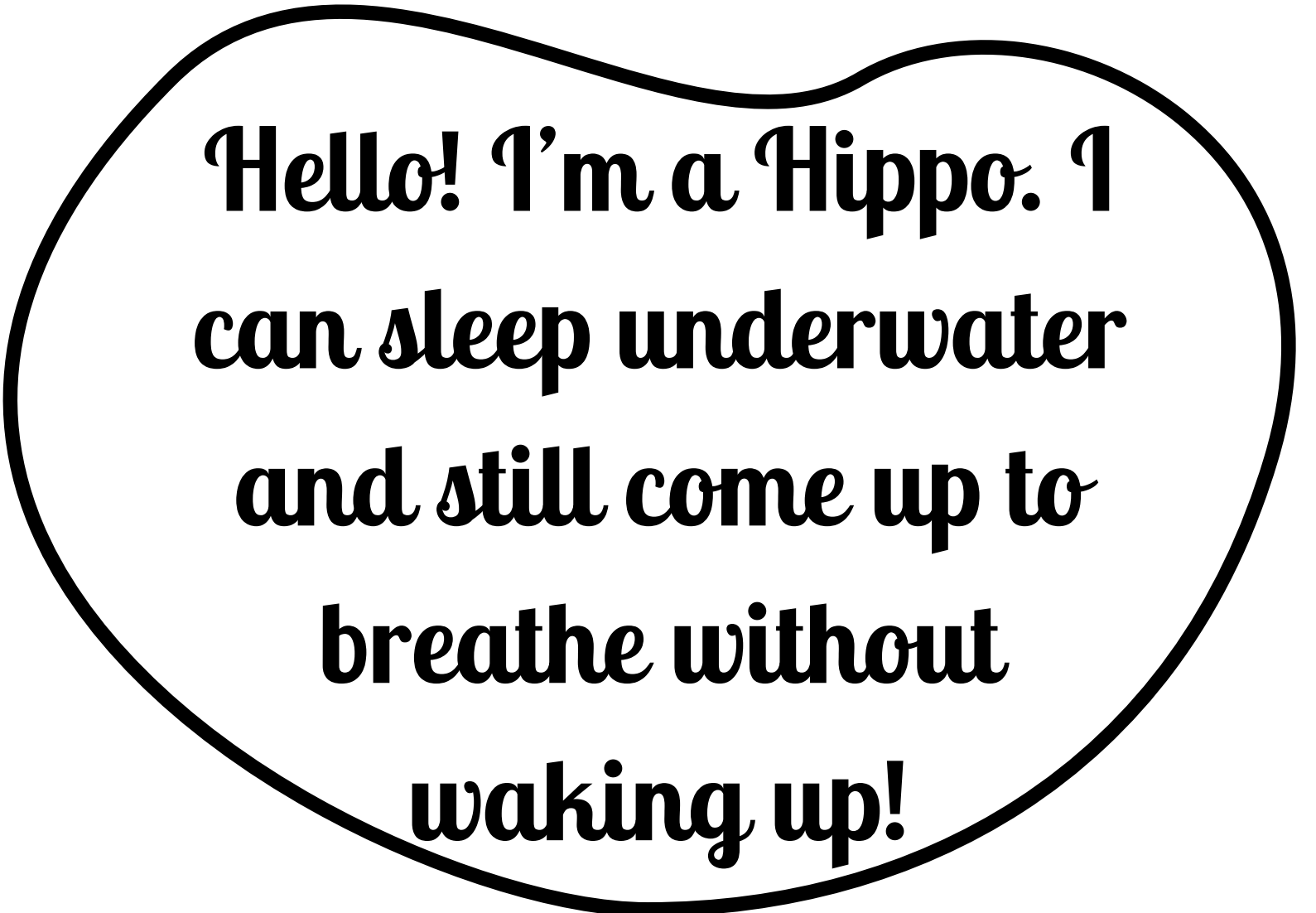
**Hi! I'm a Turtle. I can

handy is that?**





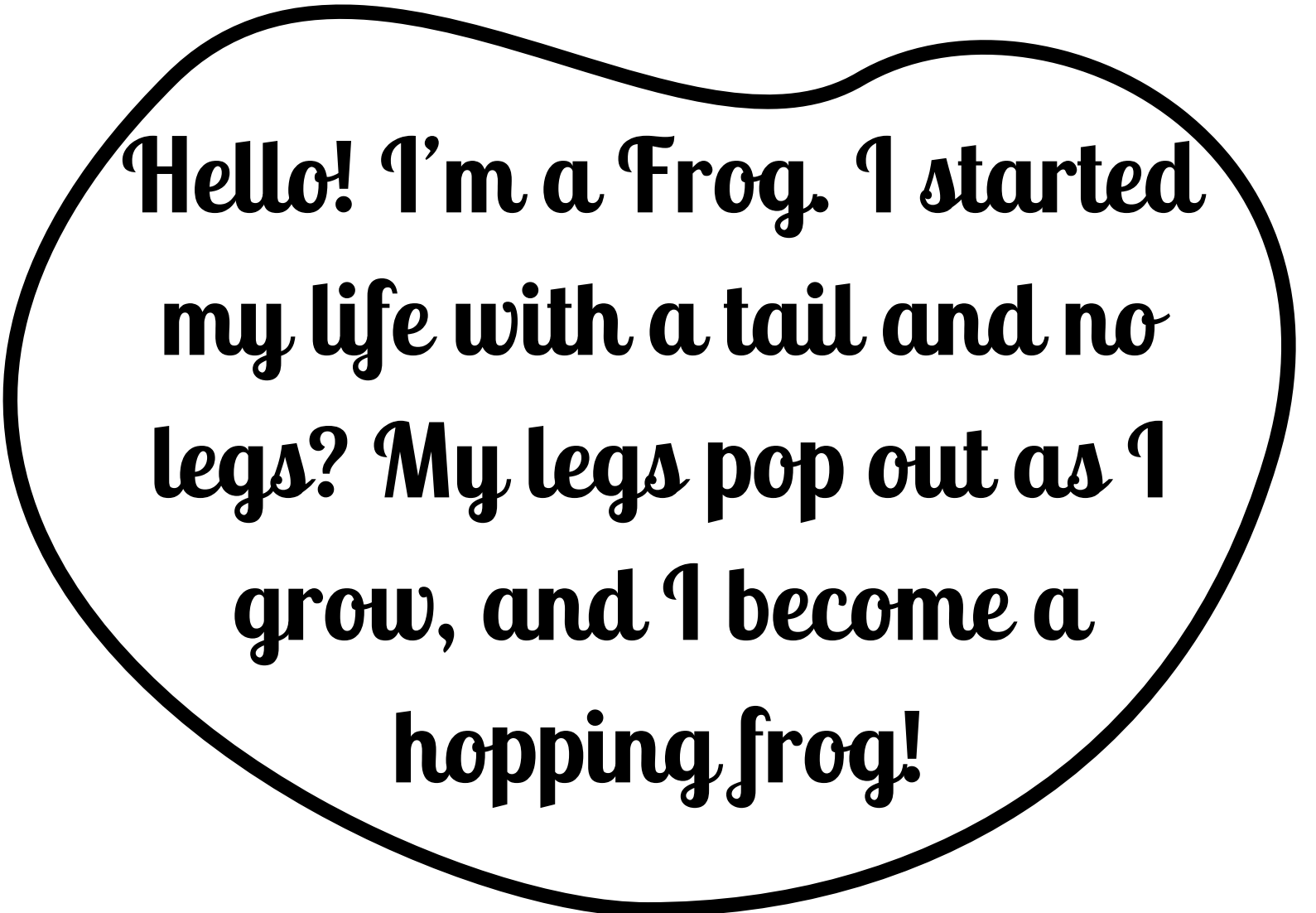
**Hello! I'm a Hippo. I

hopping frog!**





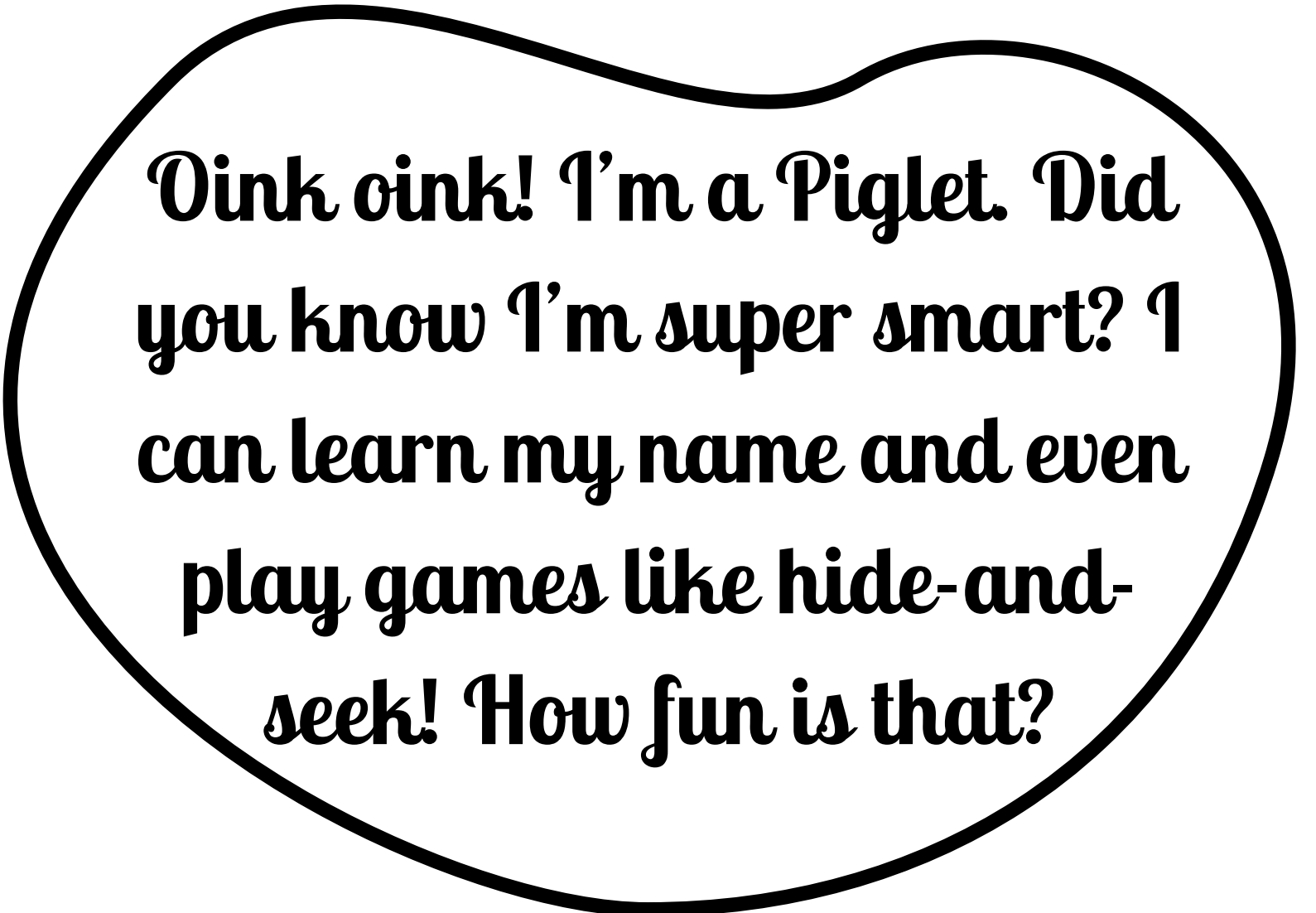
**Hello! I'm a Sheep. My

being sheared!**





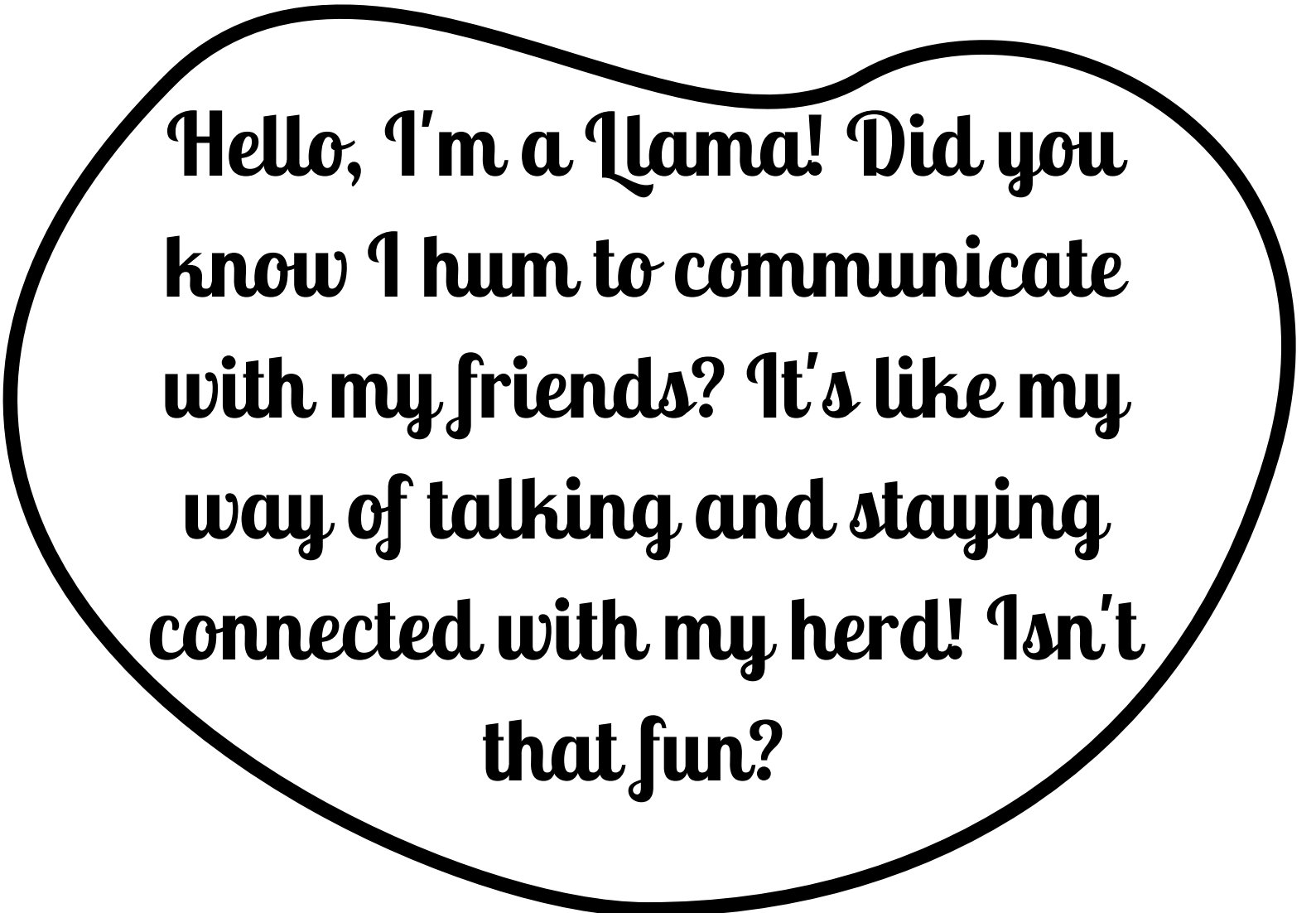
Hello there! I'm a Hare. My big ears aren't just for listening—they also help me stay cool when it's hot outside. How handy is that?





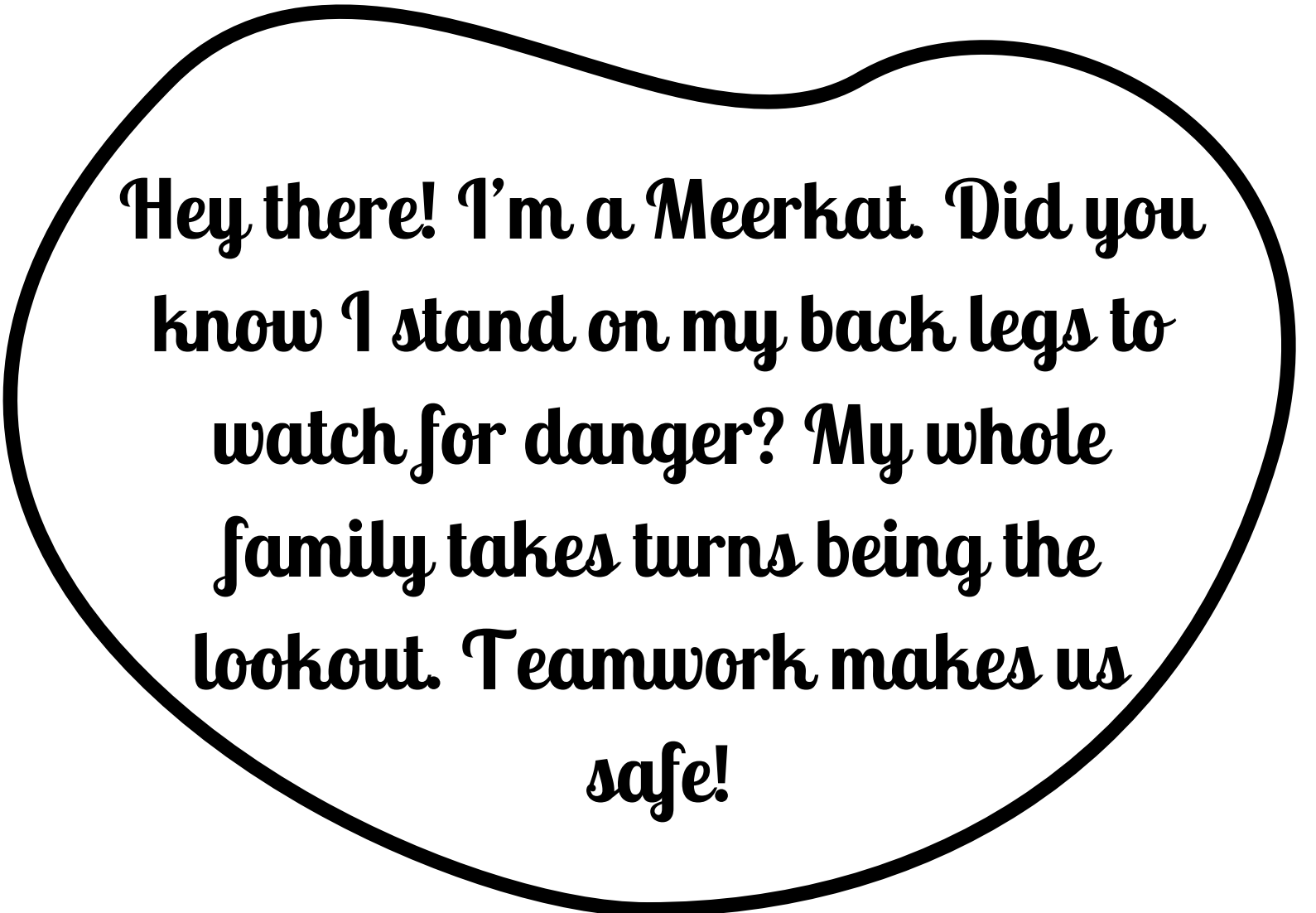
**Oink oink! I'm a Piglet. Did

seek! How fun is that?**





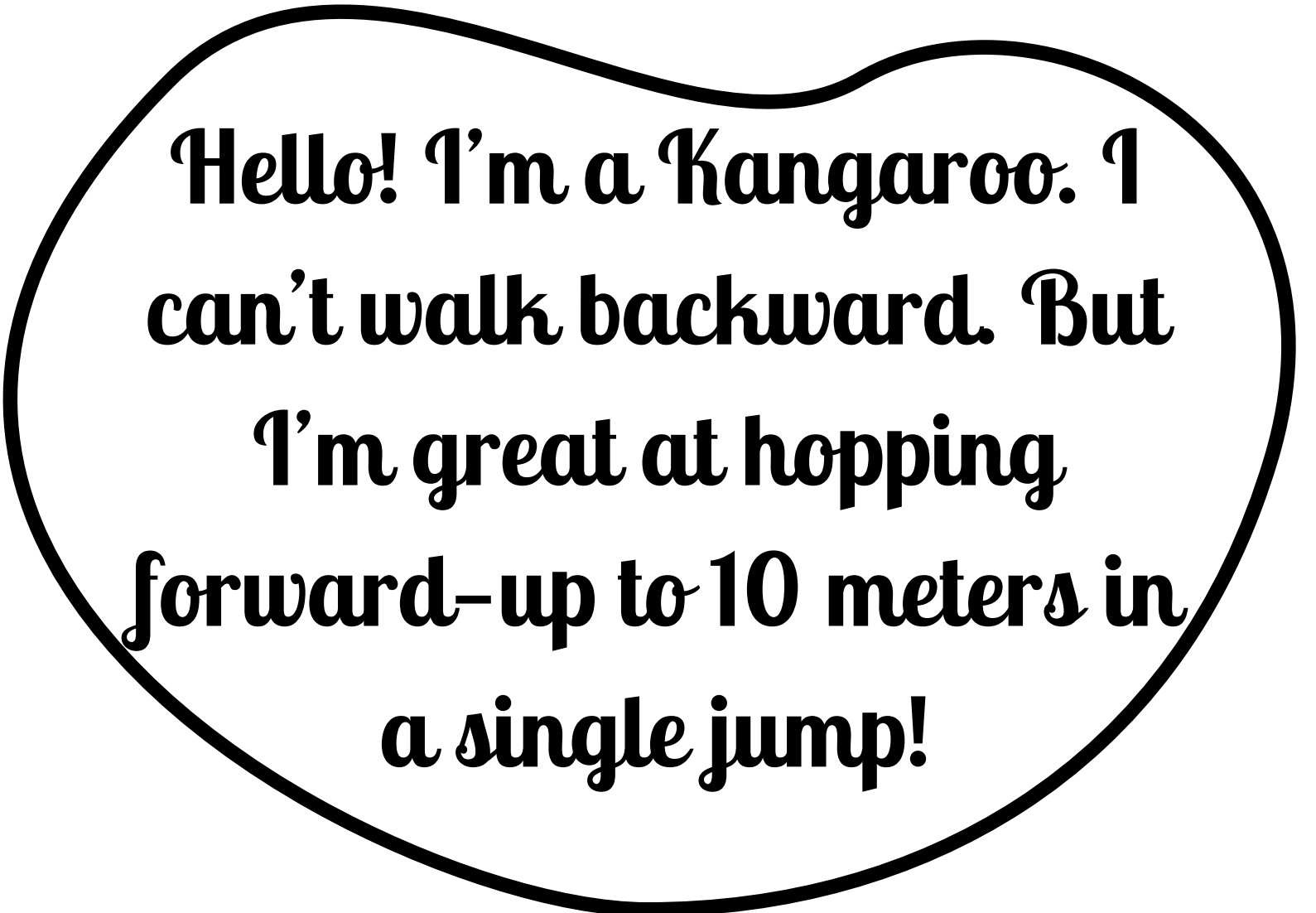
**Hello, I'm a Llama! Did you

that fun?**





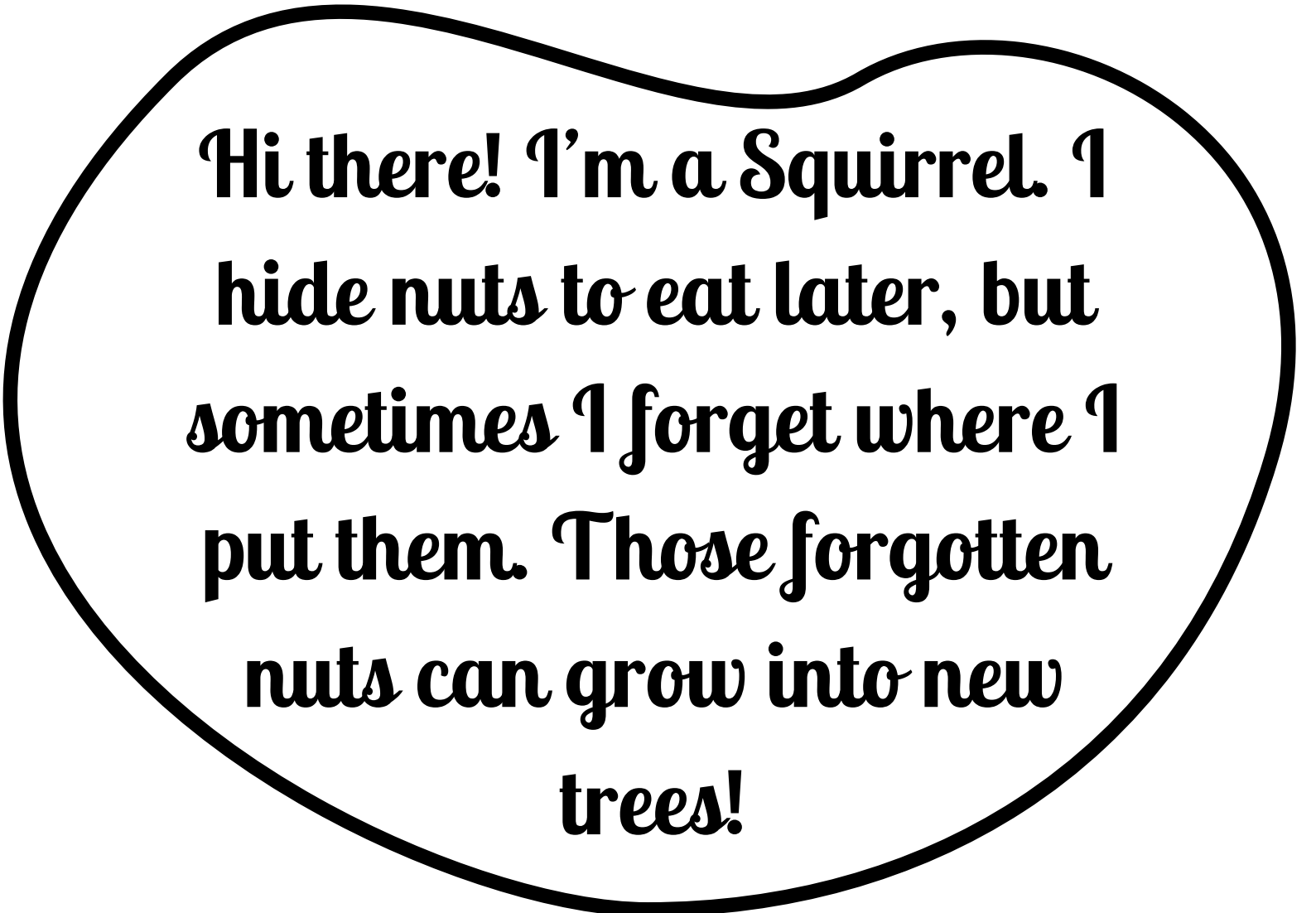
Hey there! I'm a Meerkat. Did you know I stand on my back legs to watch for danger? My whole family takes turns being the lookout. Teamwork makes us safe!





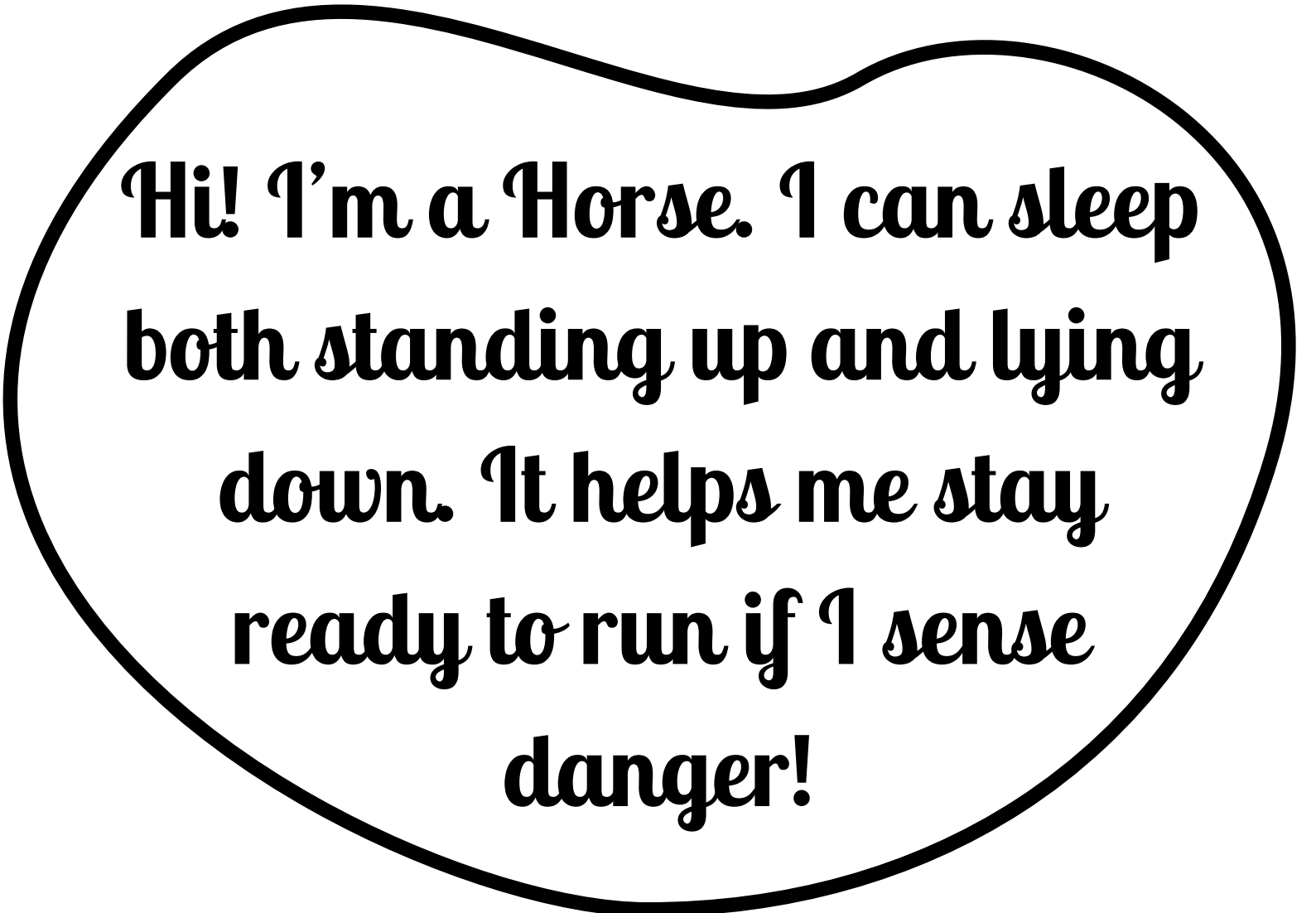
**Hello! I'm a Kangaroo. I

trees!**



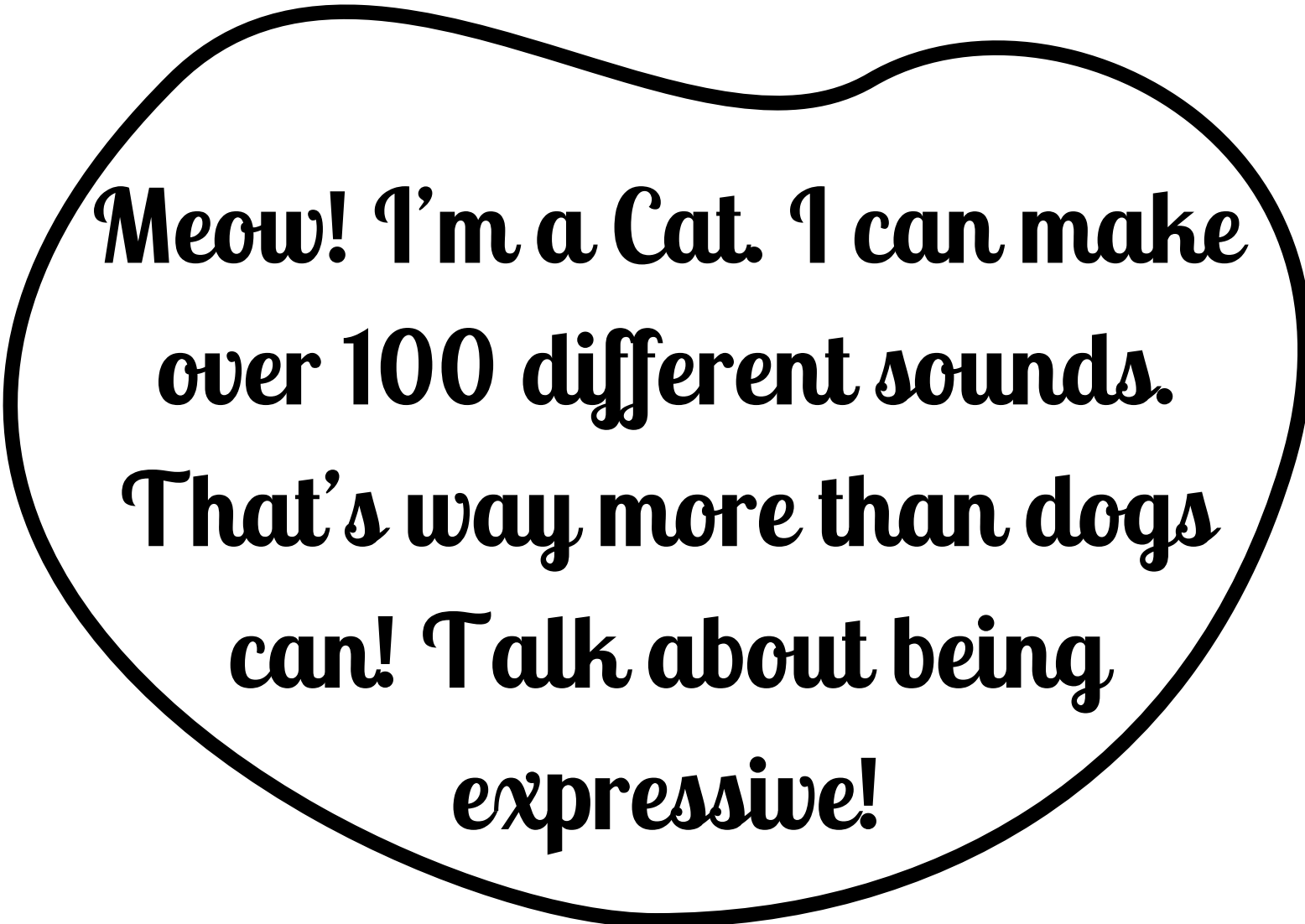


**Hi! I'm a Horse. I can sleep

danger!**



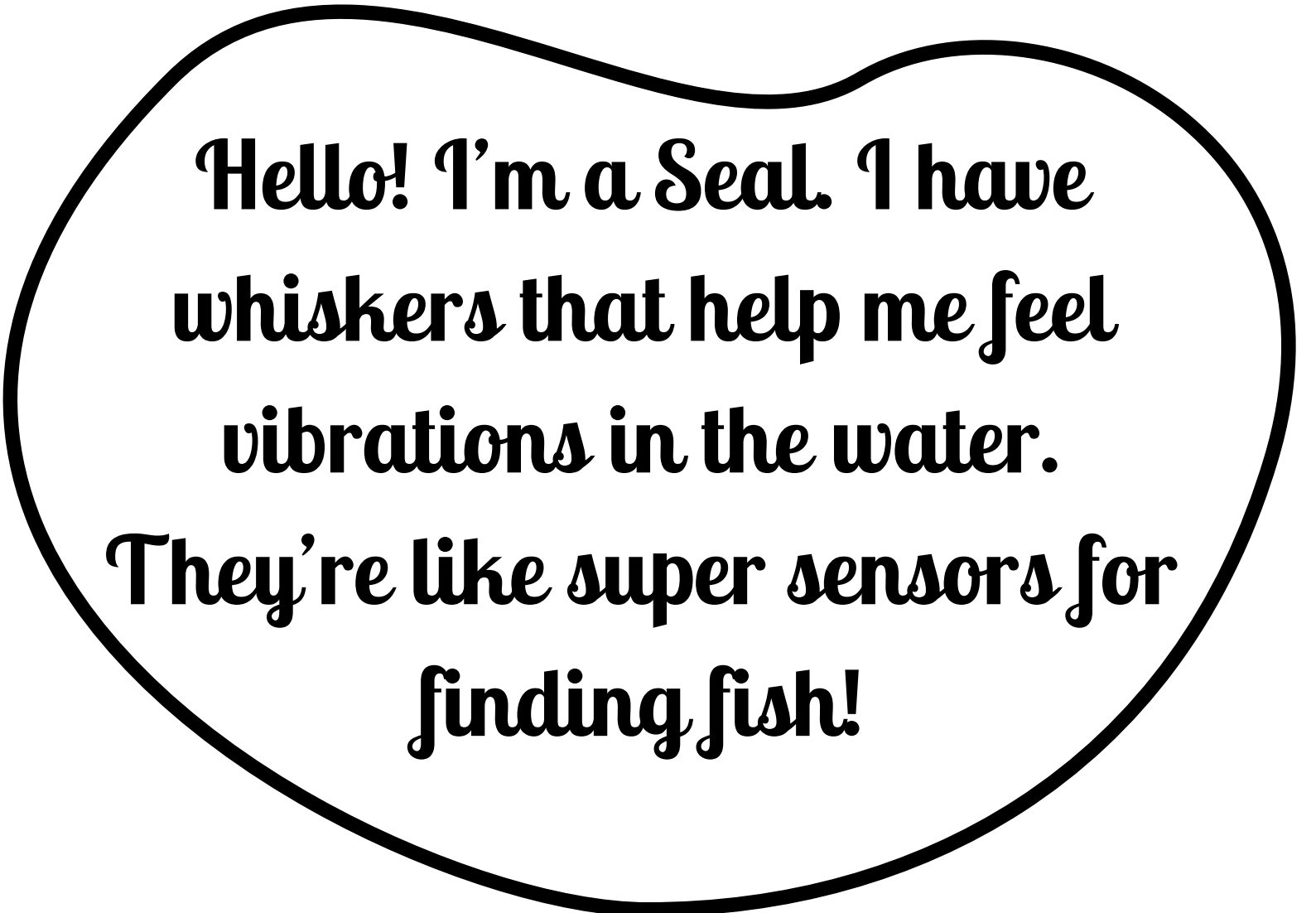
**Hello! I'm a Baby Fox or

my parents!**





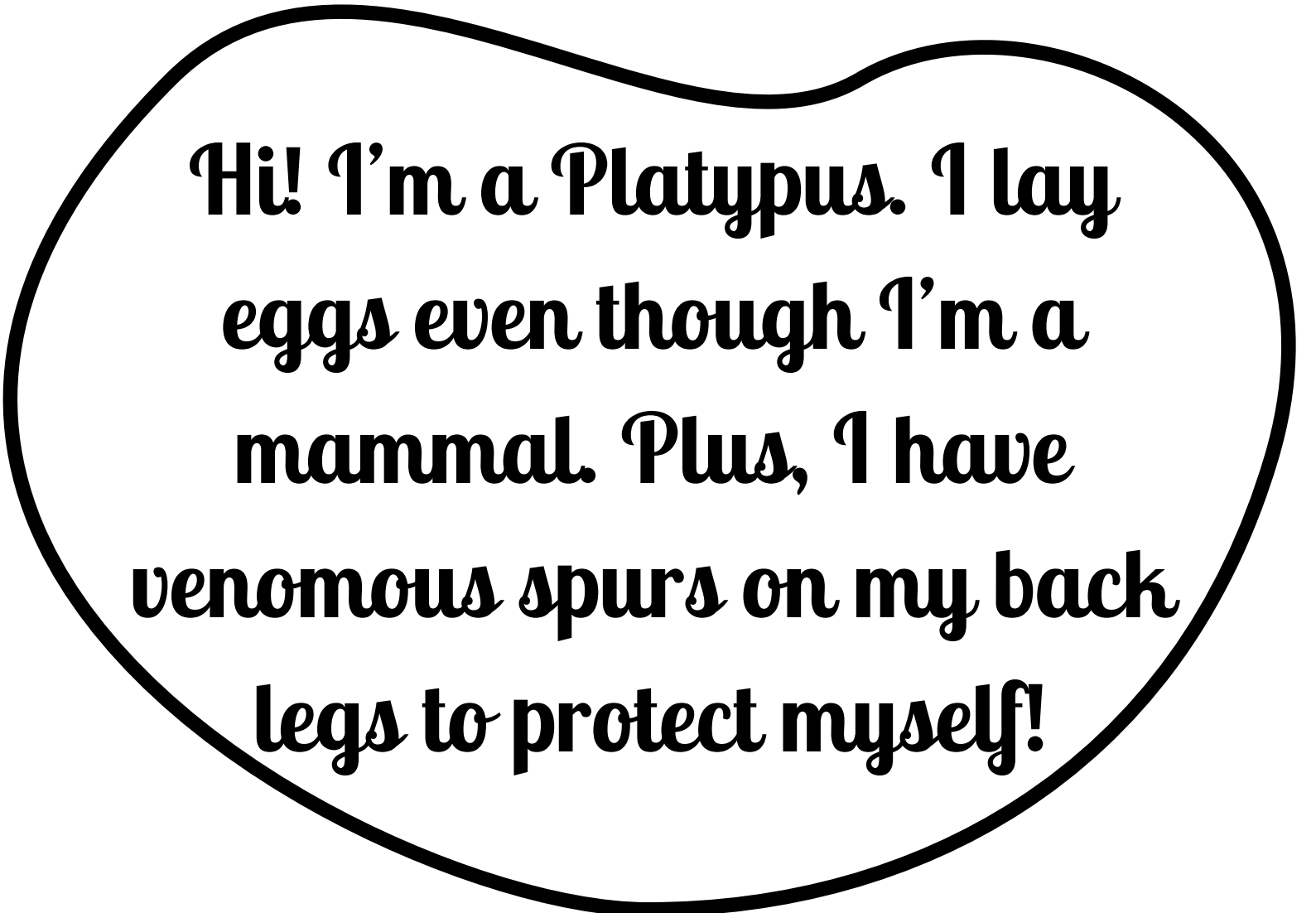
**Meow! I'm a Cat. I can make

legs to protect myself!**





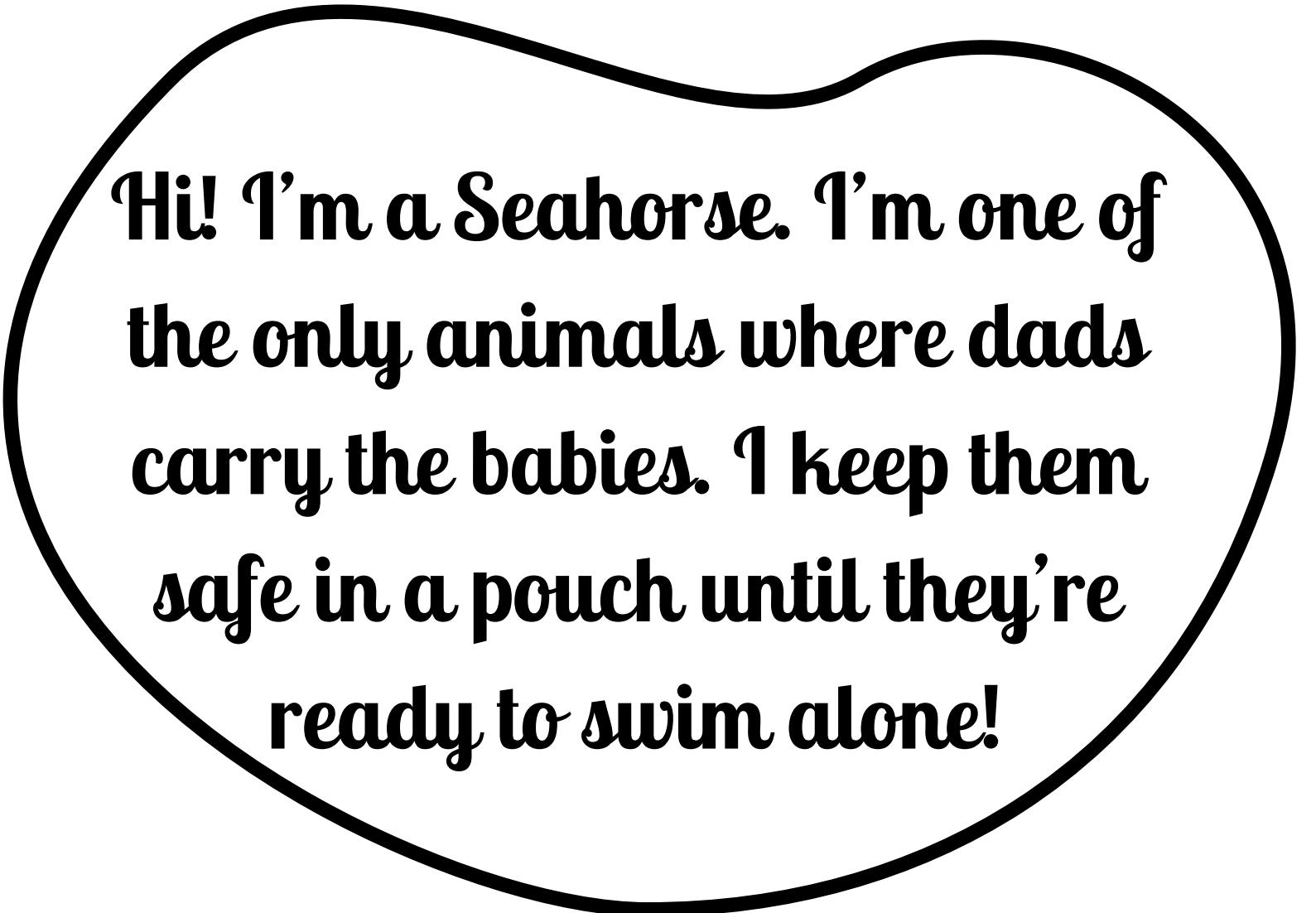
**Hi there! I'm a Rhino. My horn

cool, right?**





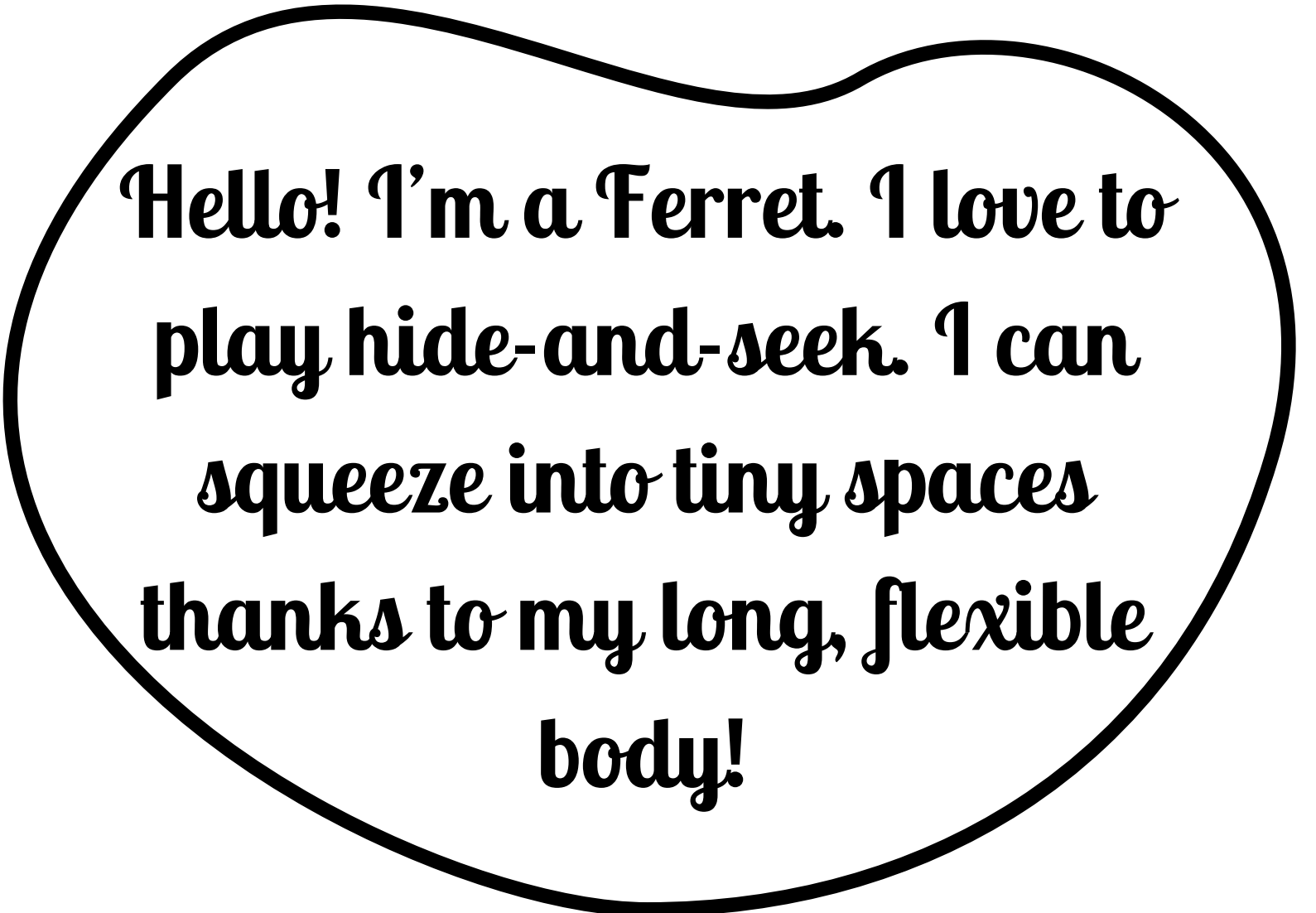
**Hi there! I'm a Lion cub. I

body!**



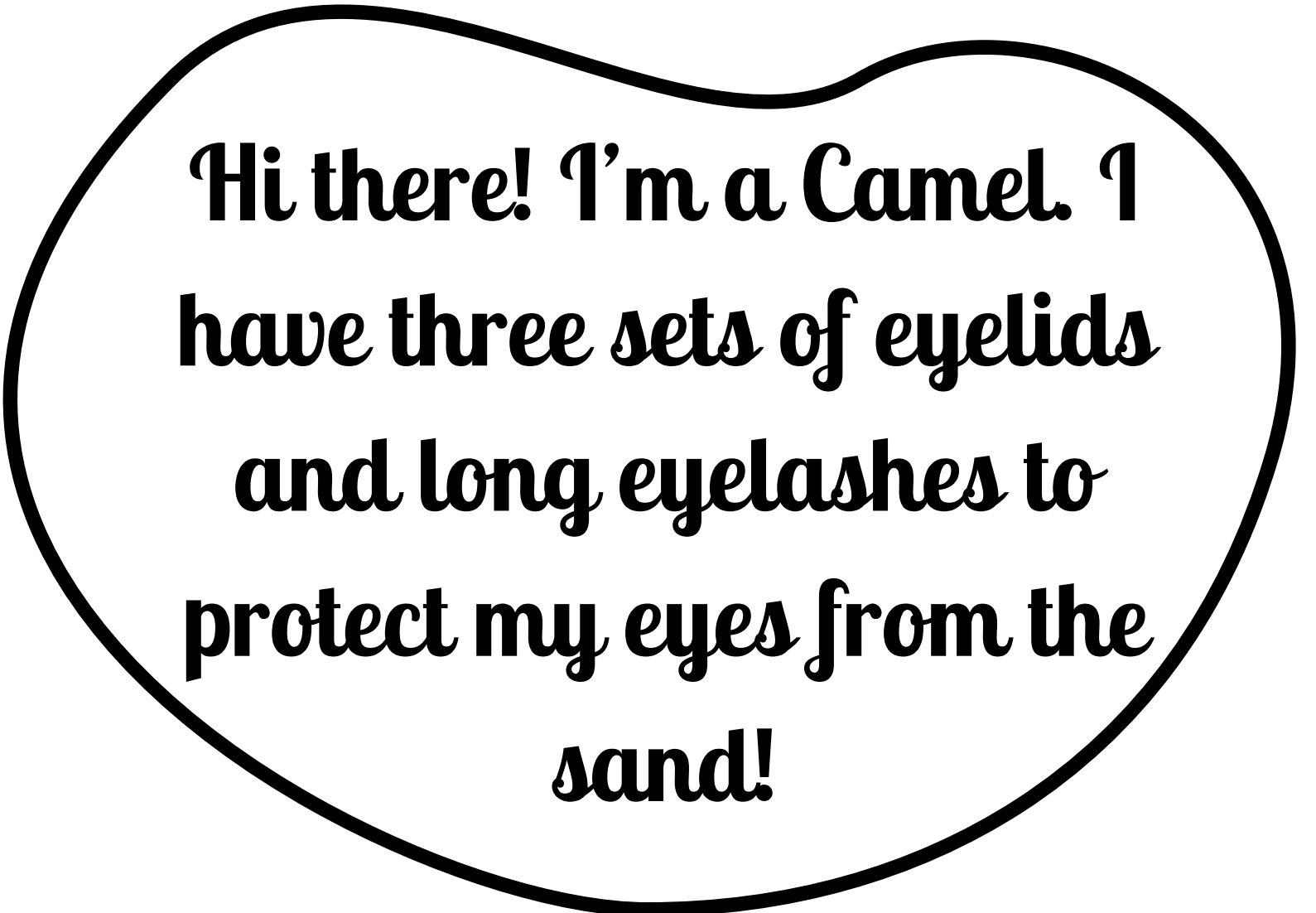
**Hi there! I'm a Panda. I eat a

most.**





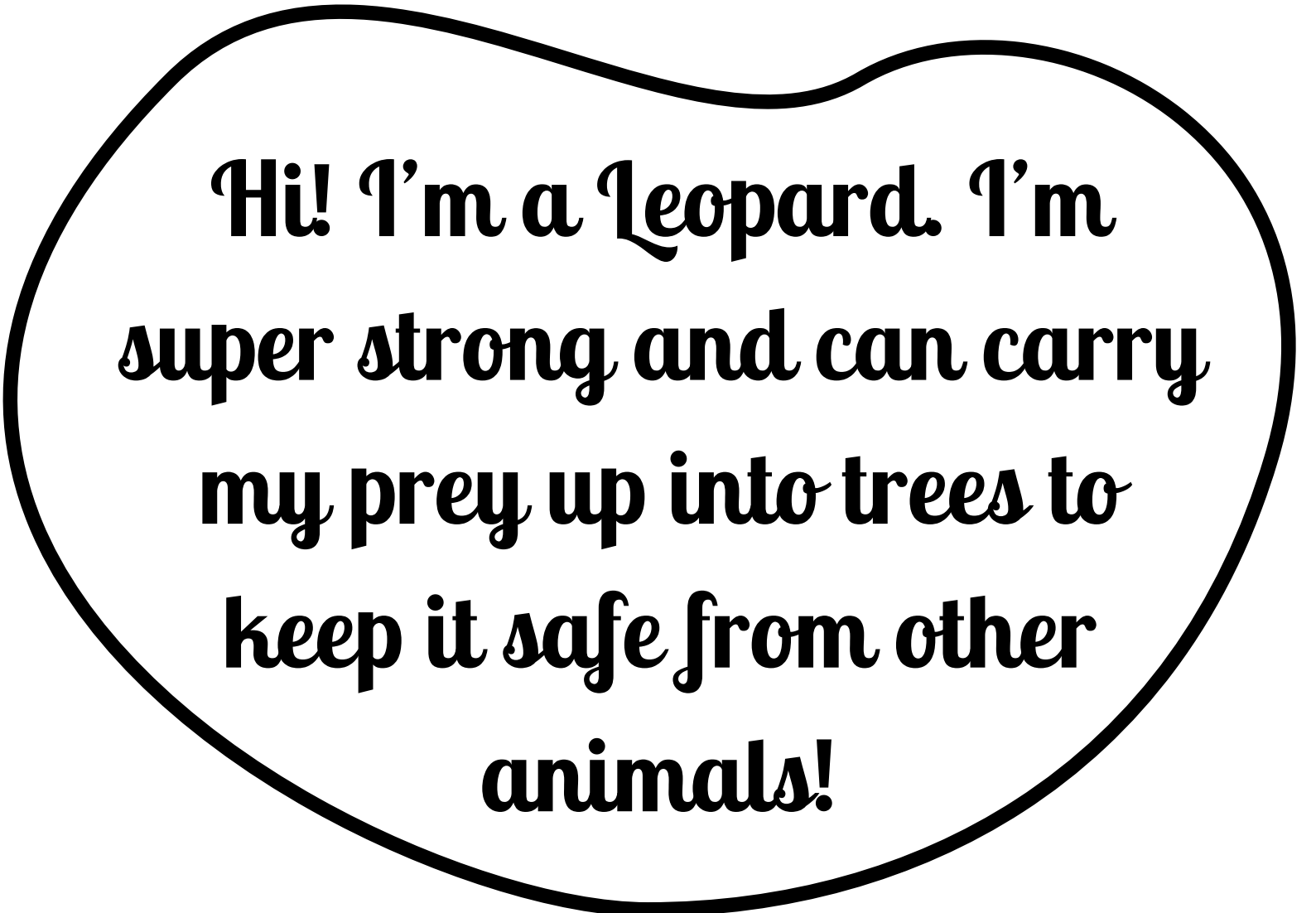
**Hello! I'm a Chameleon. I

around me!**





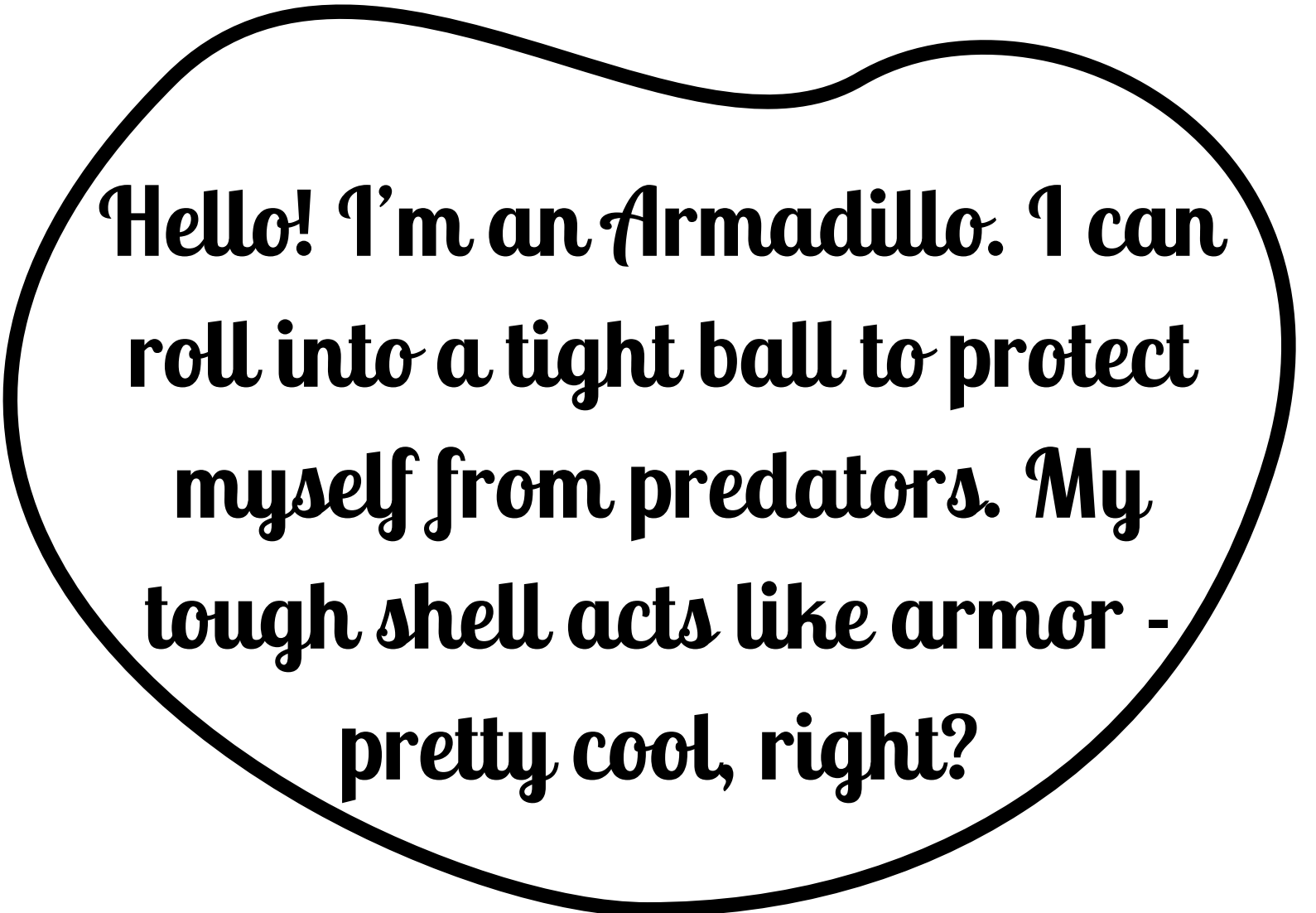
**Hi there! I'm a Camel. I

sand!**





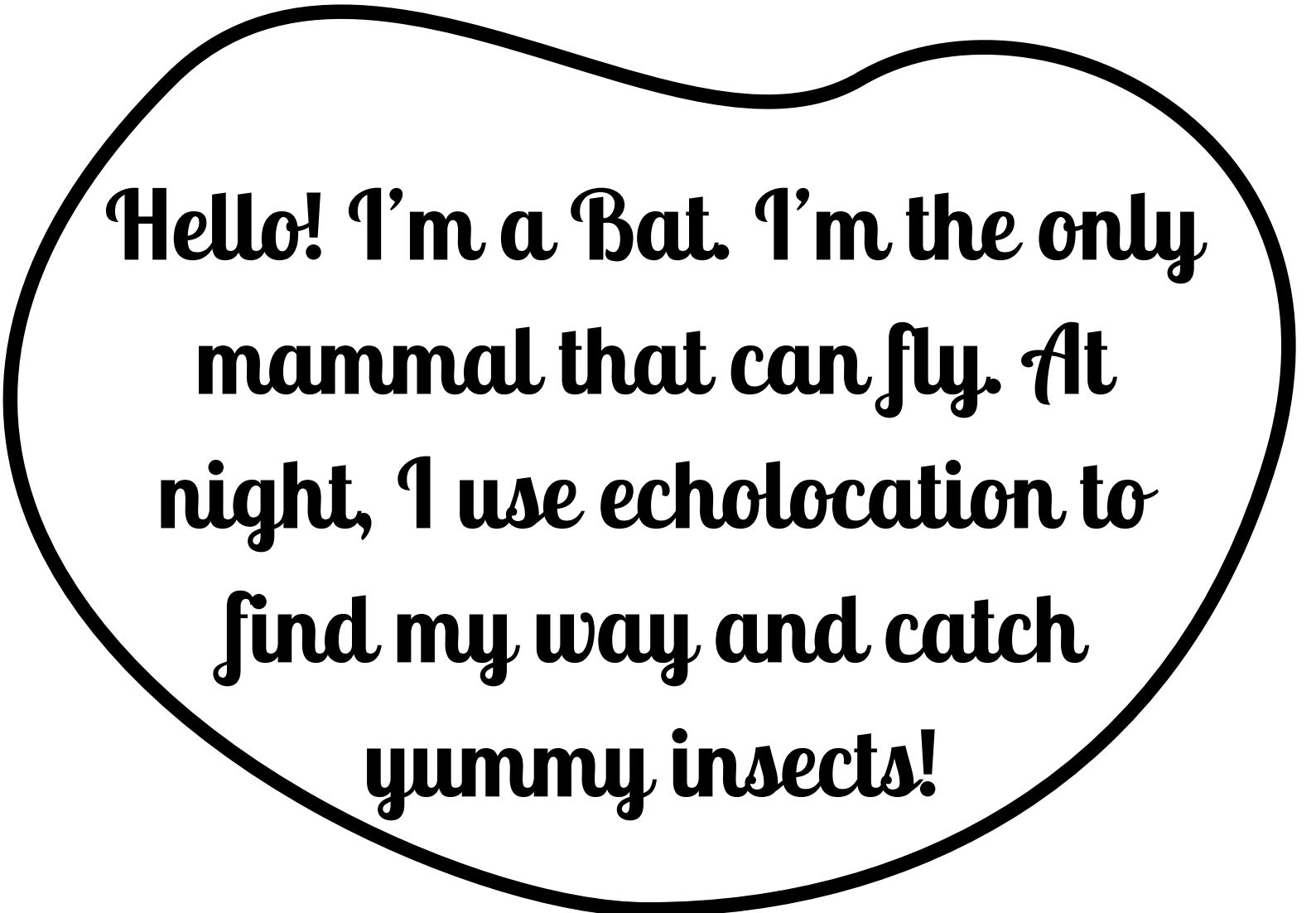
**Hi! I'm a Leopard. I'm

huh?**



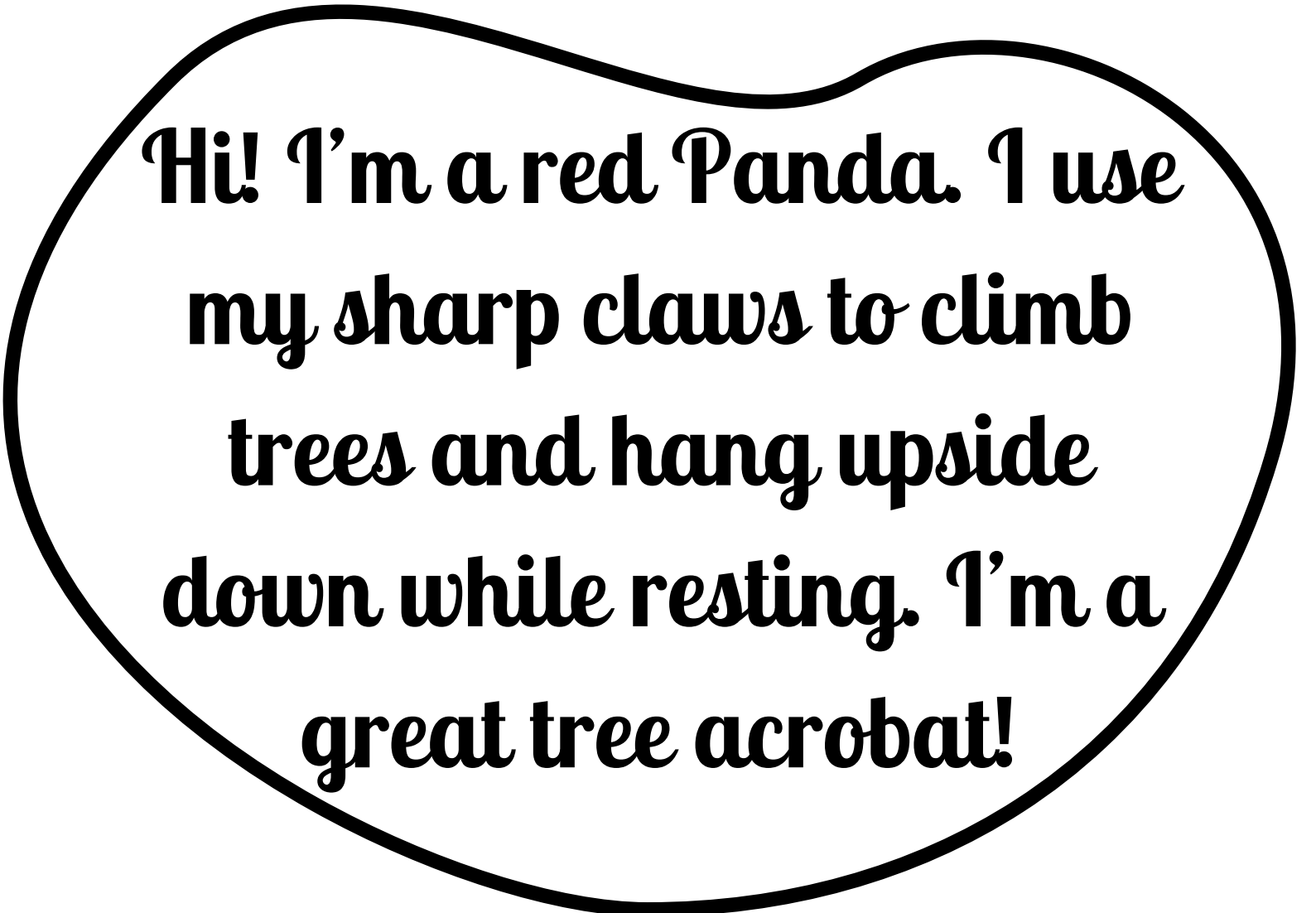


**Hello! I'm a Fennec Fox. My

releasing heat!**



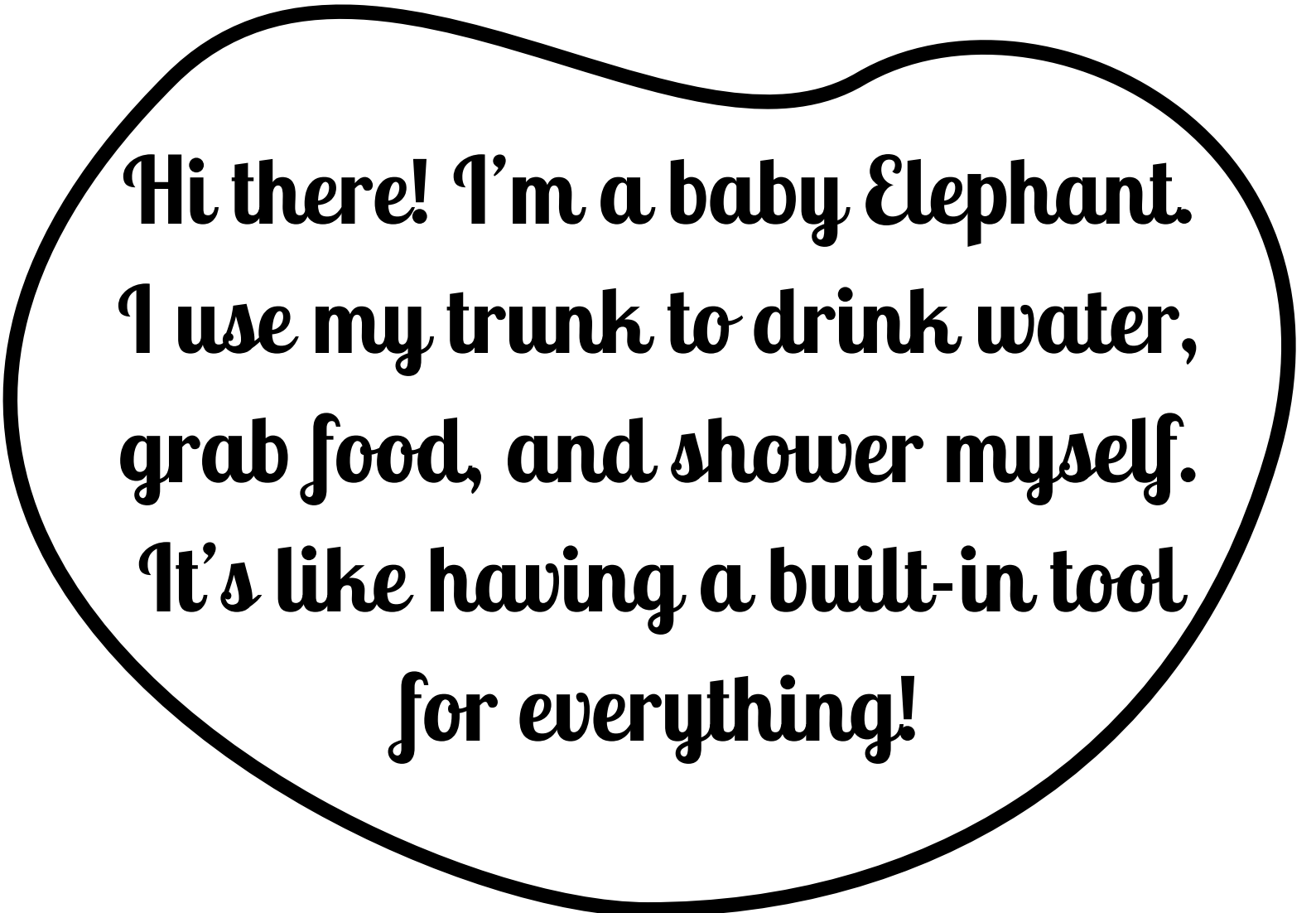
**Hi! We are Penguins. We

fish!**





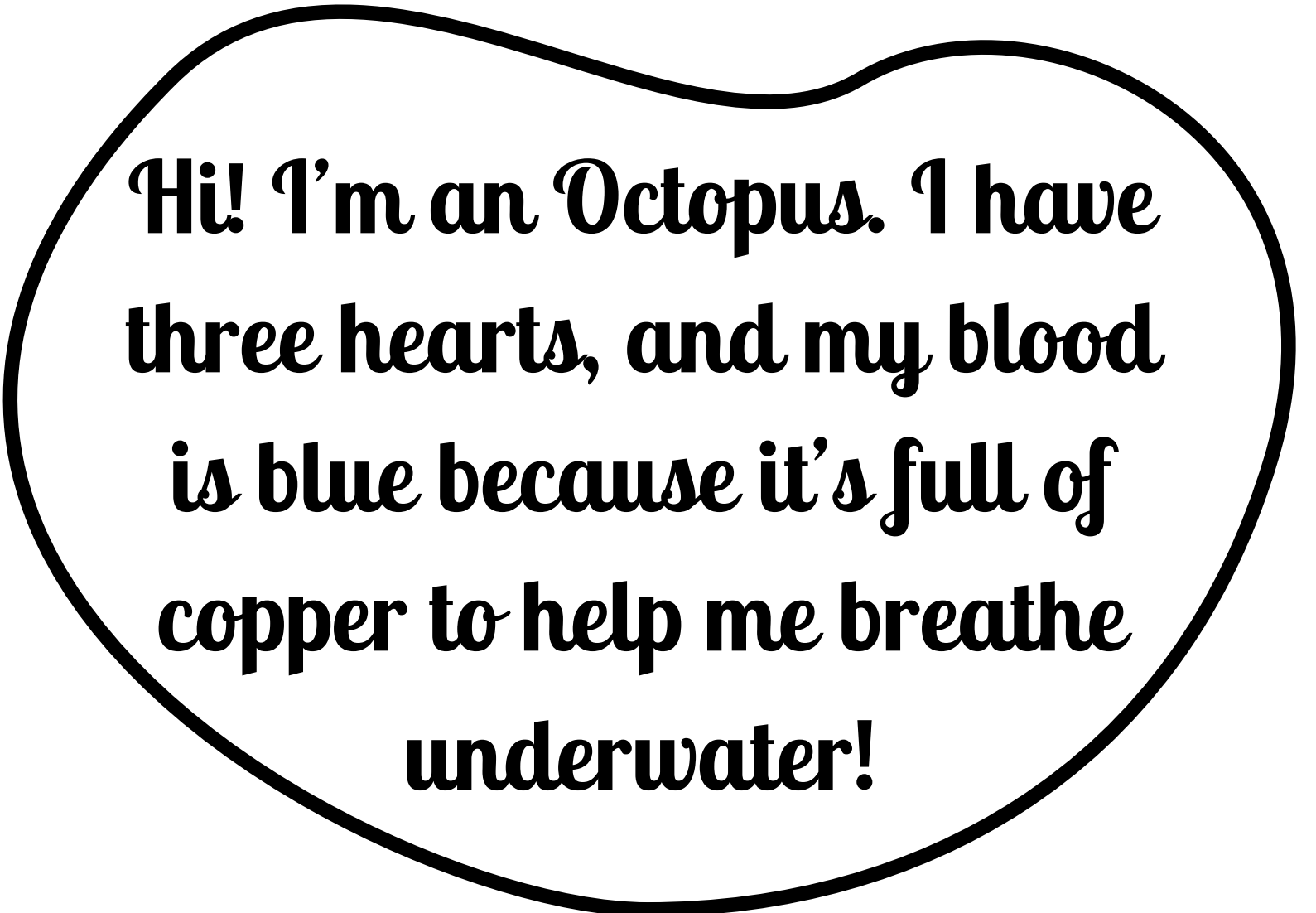
**Hi! I'm a red Panda. I use

great tree acrobat!**



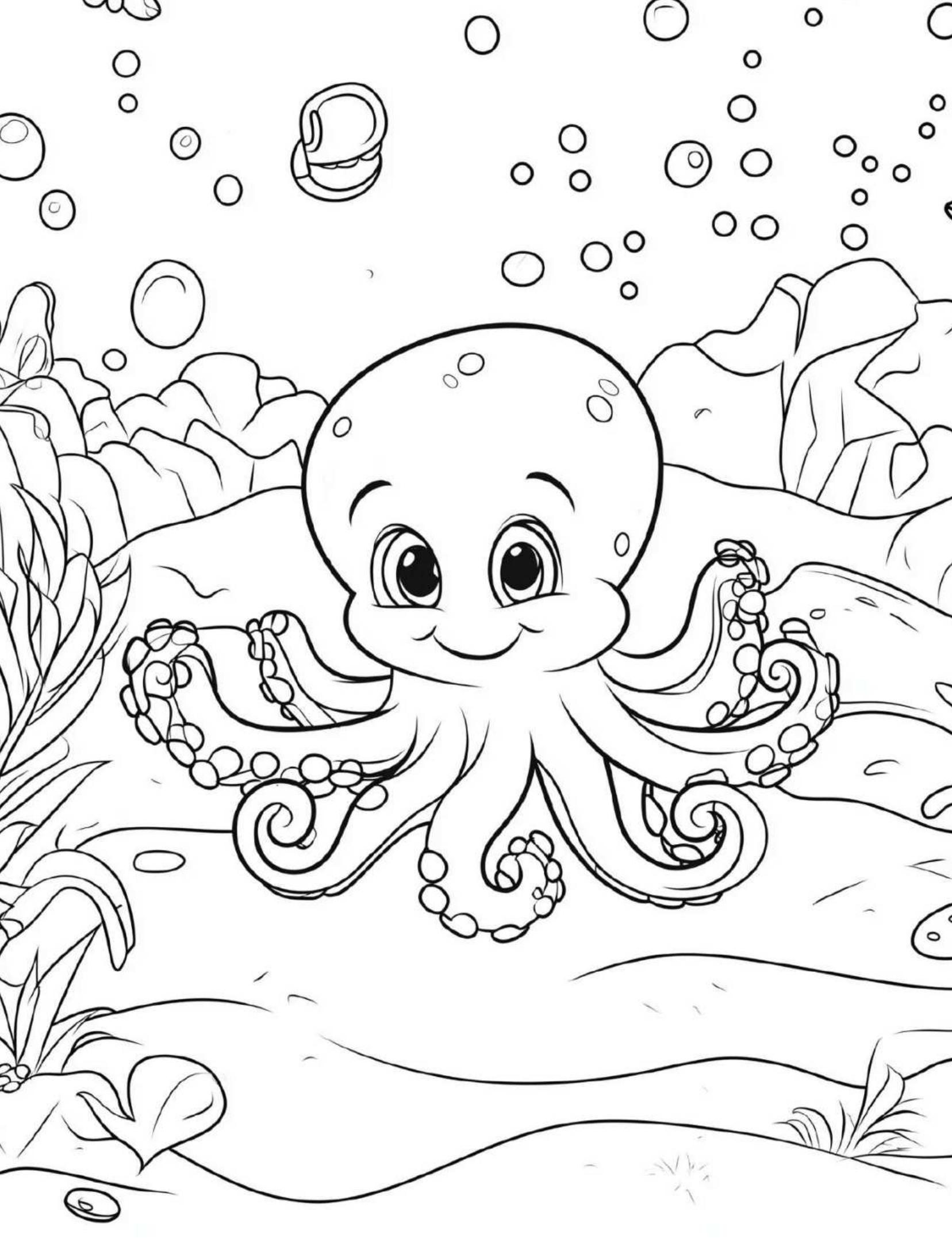


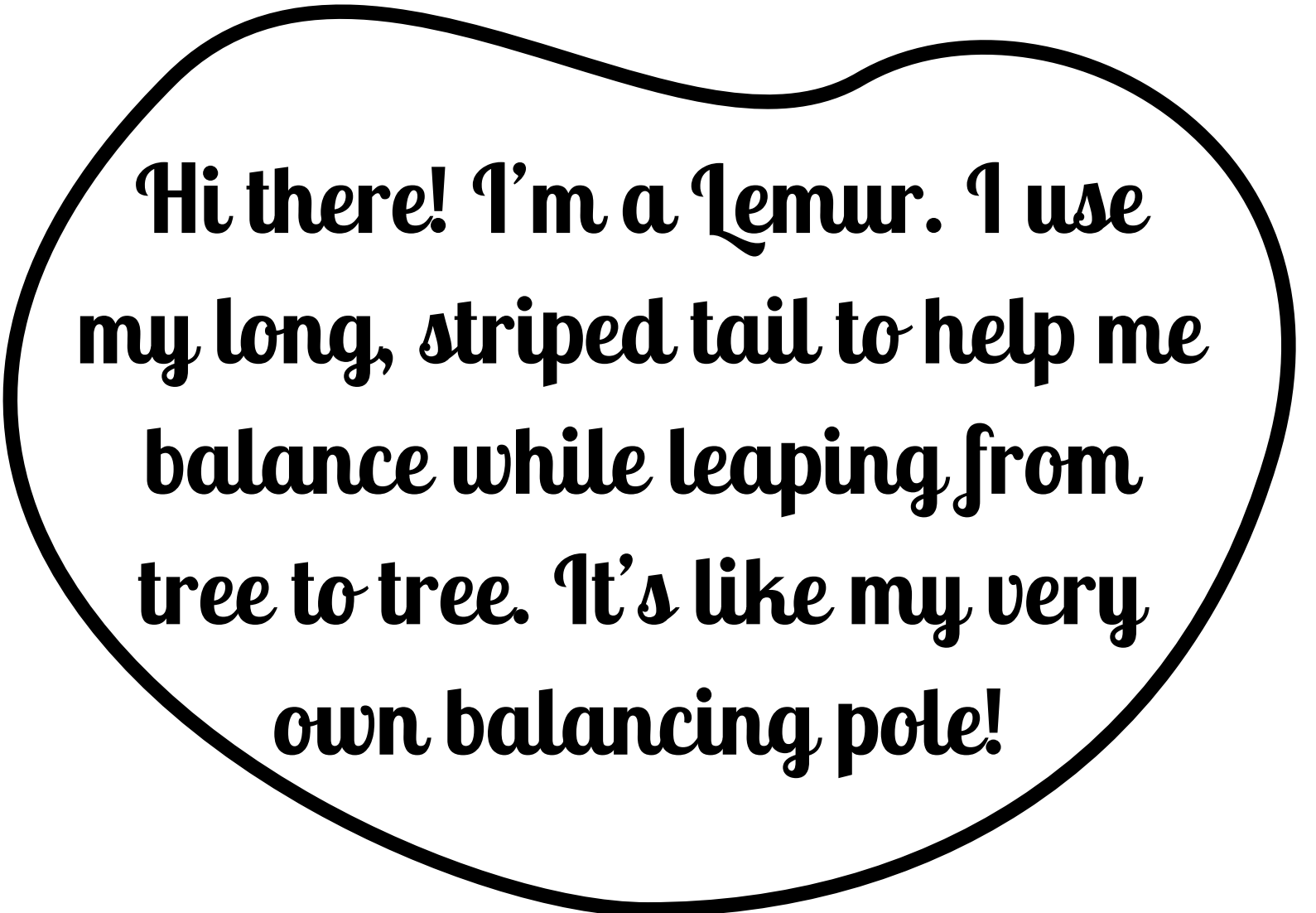
**Hi there! I'm a baby Elephant.

for everything!**





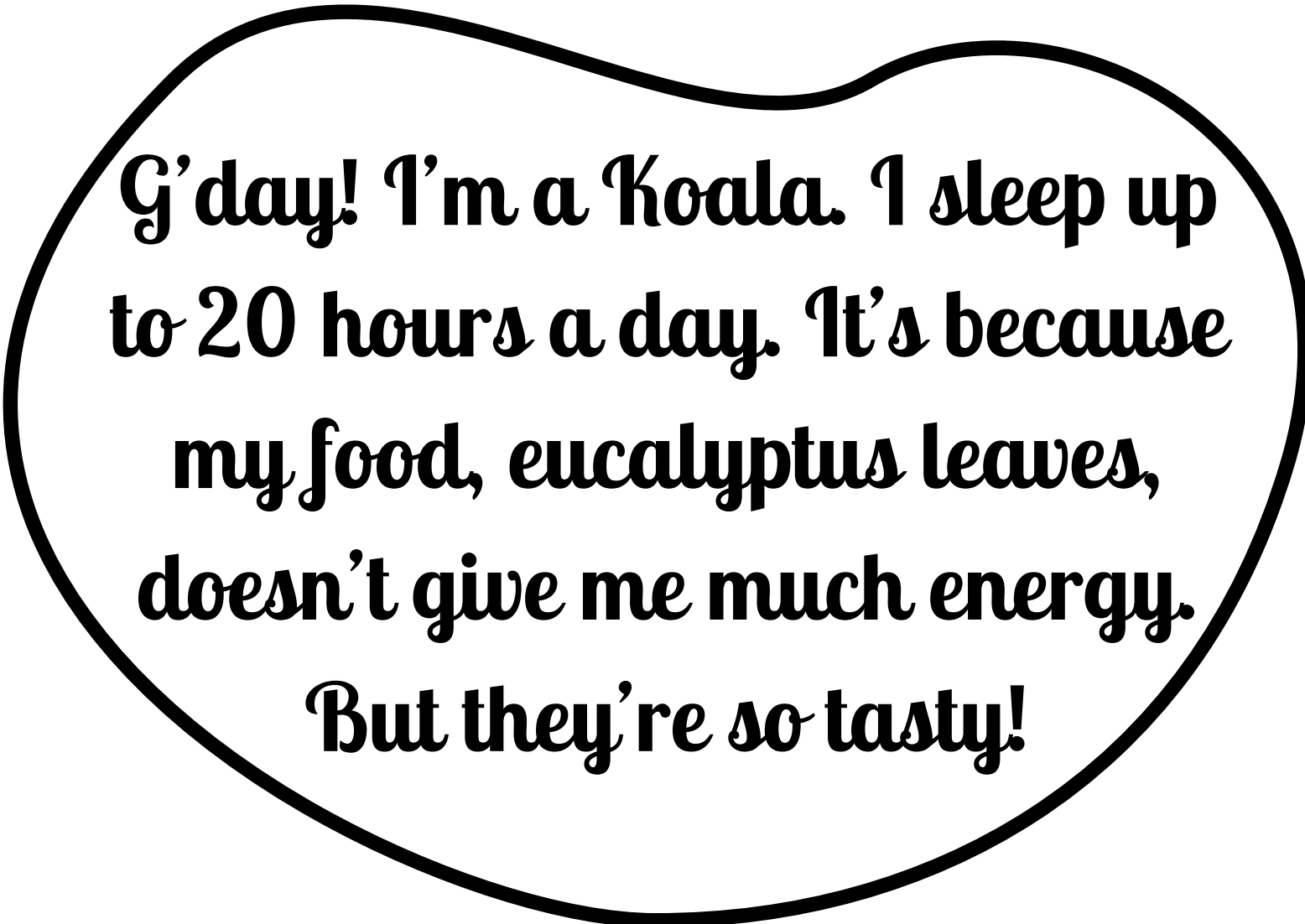
**Hi! I'm an Octopus. I have

underwater!**





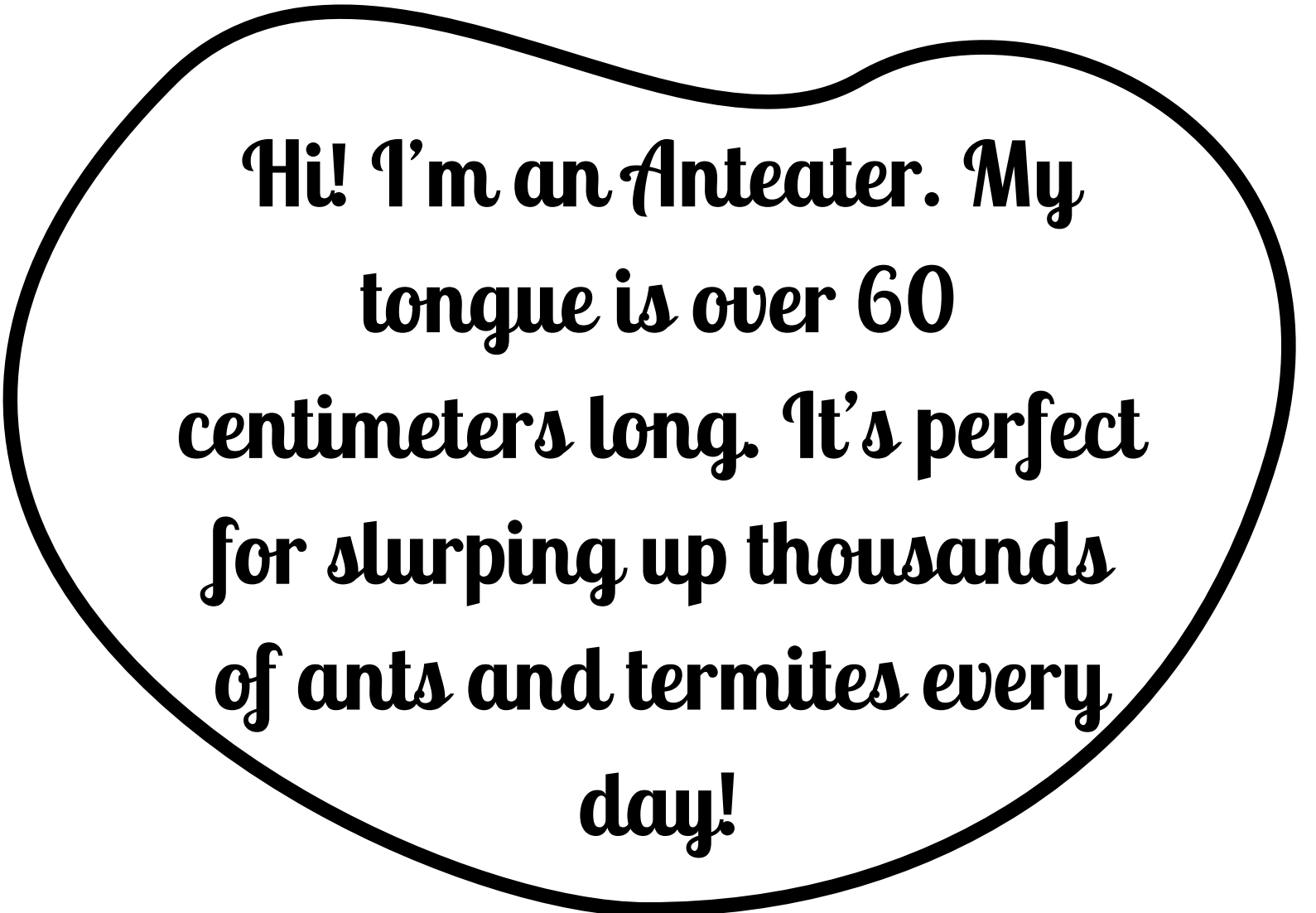
**Hi there! I'm a Lemur. I use

healthy!**



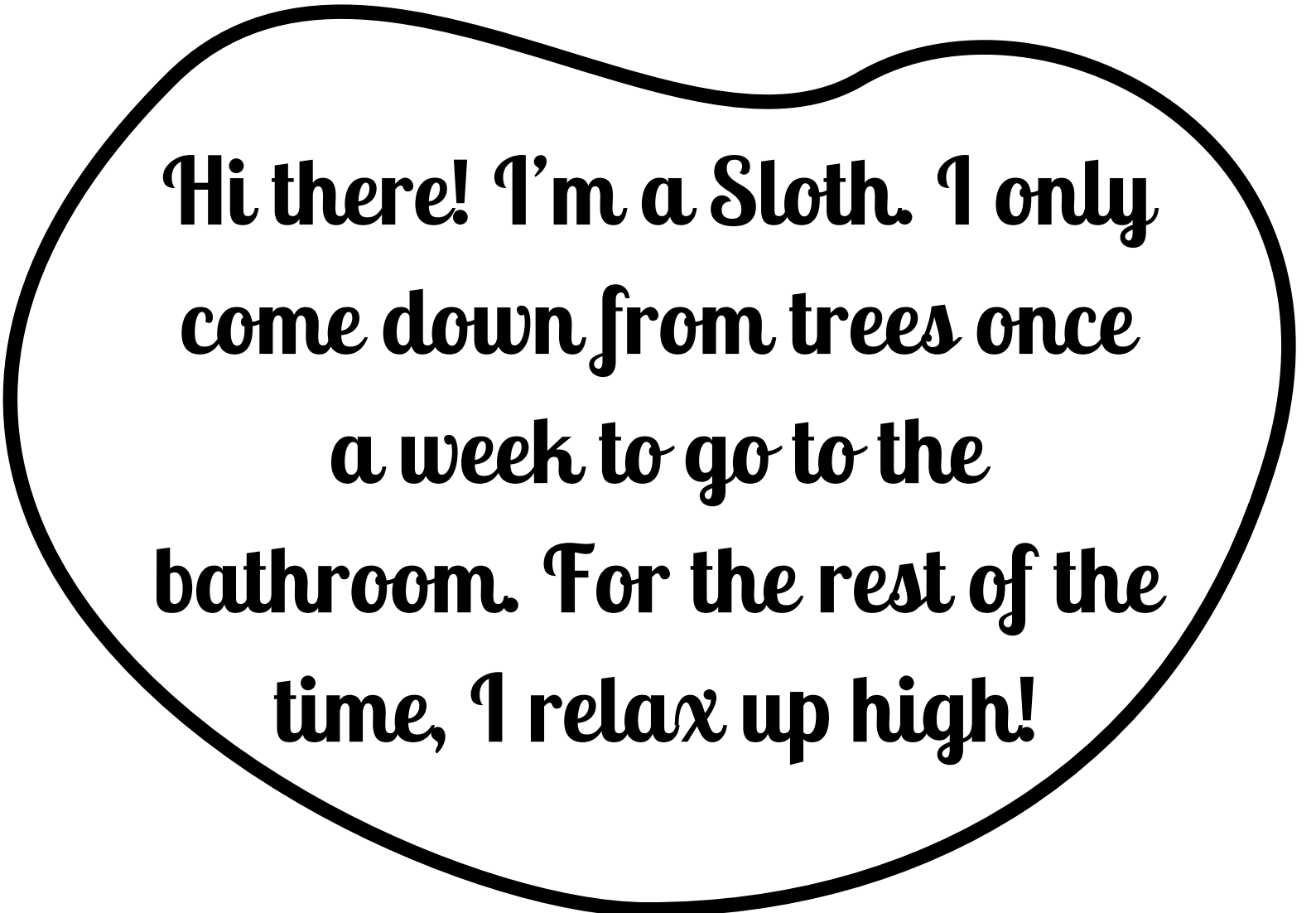


**Hey! I'm a Raccoon. I use

time, I relax up high!**





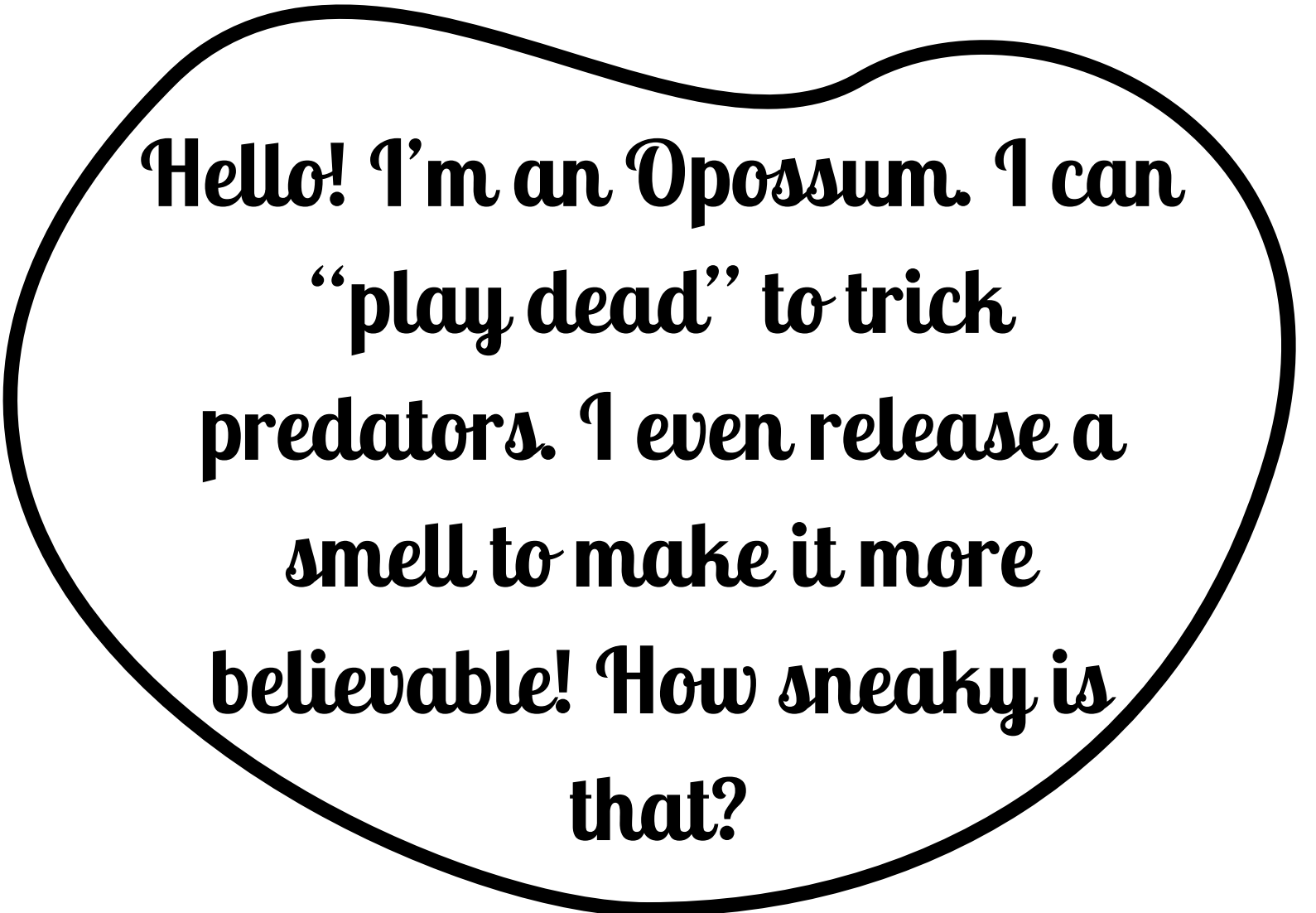
**Hello! I'm a Tarsier. My

everything!**





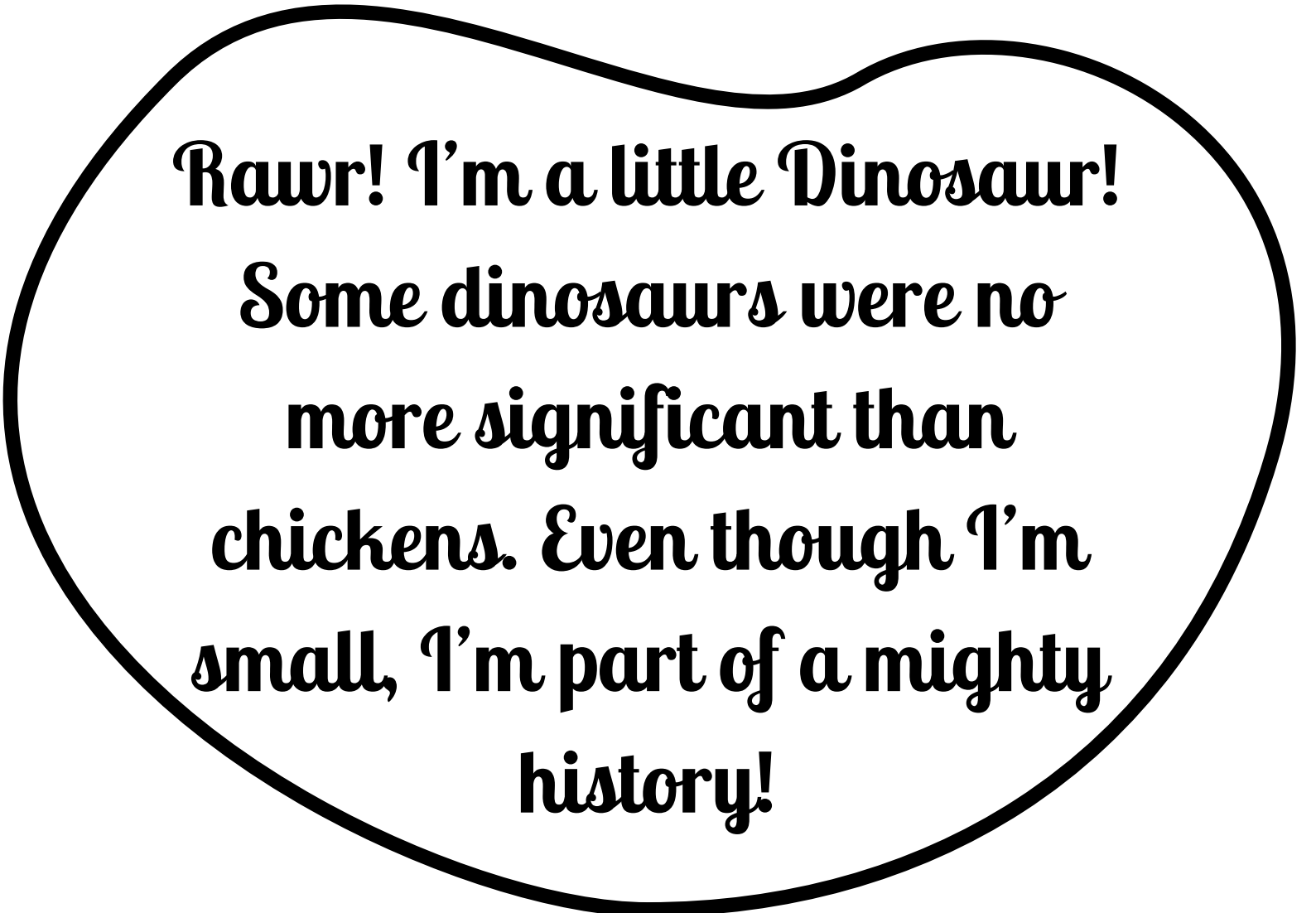
**Hi there! I'm a Baby Ostrich. I

parents!**





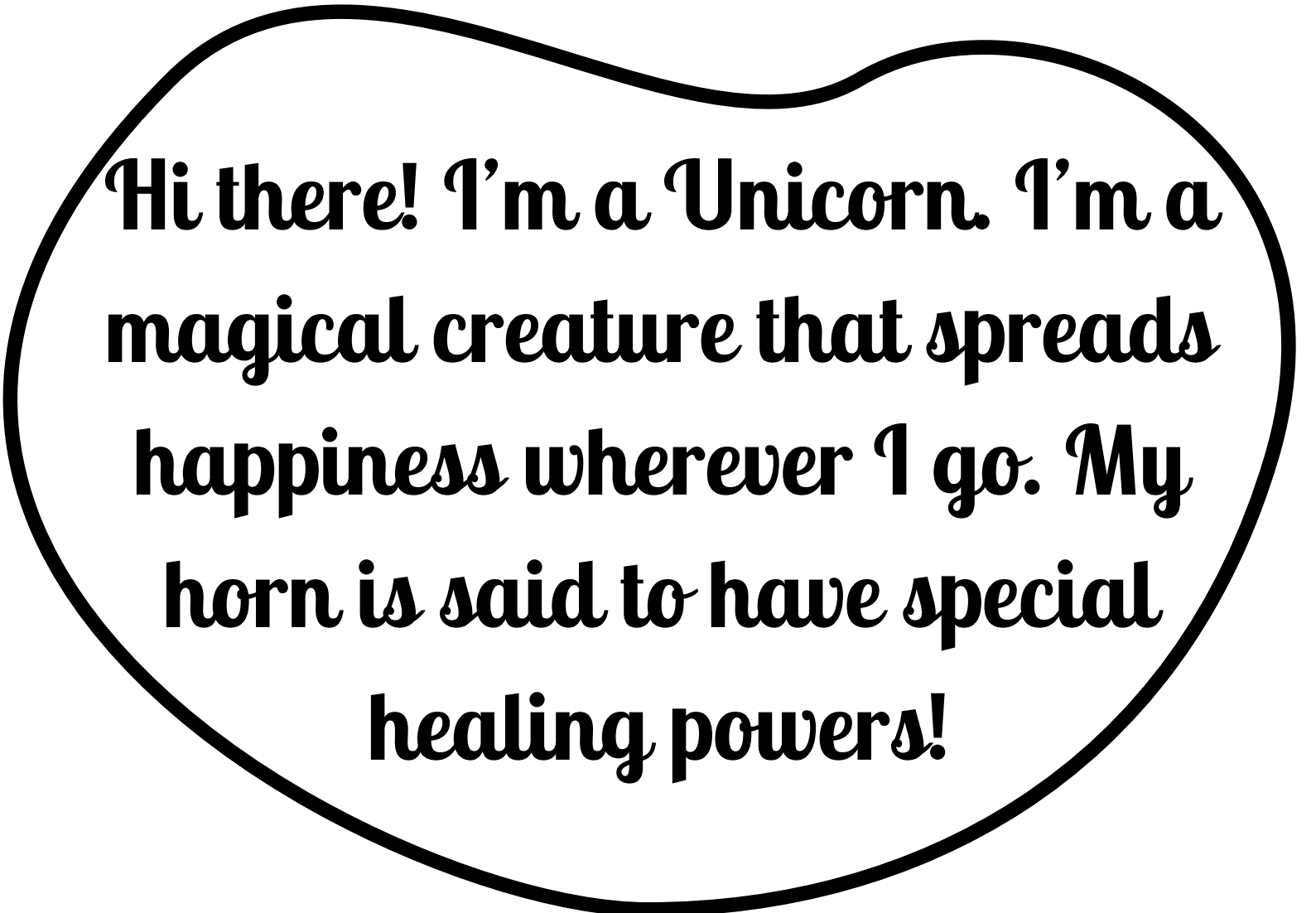
**Hello! I'm an Opossum. I can
