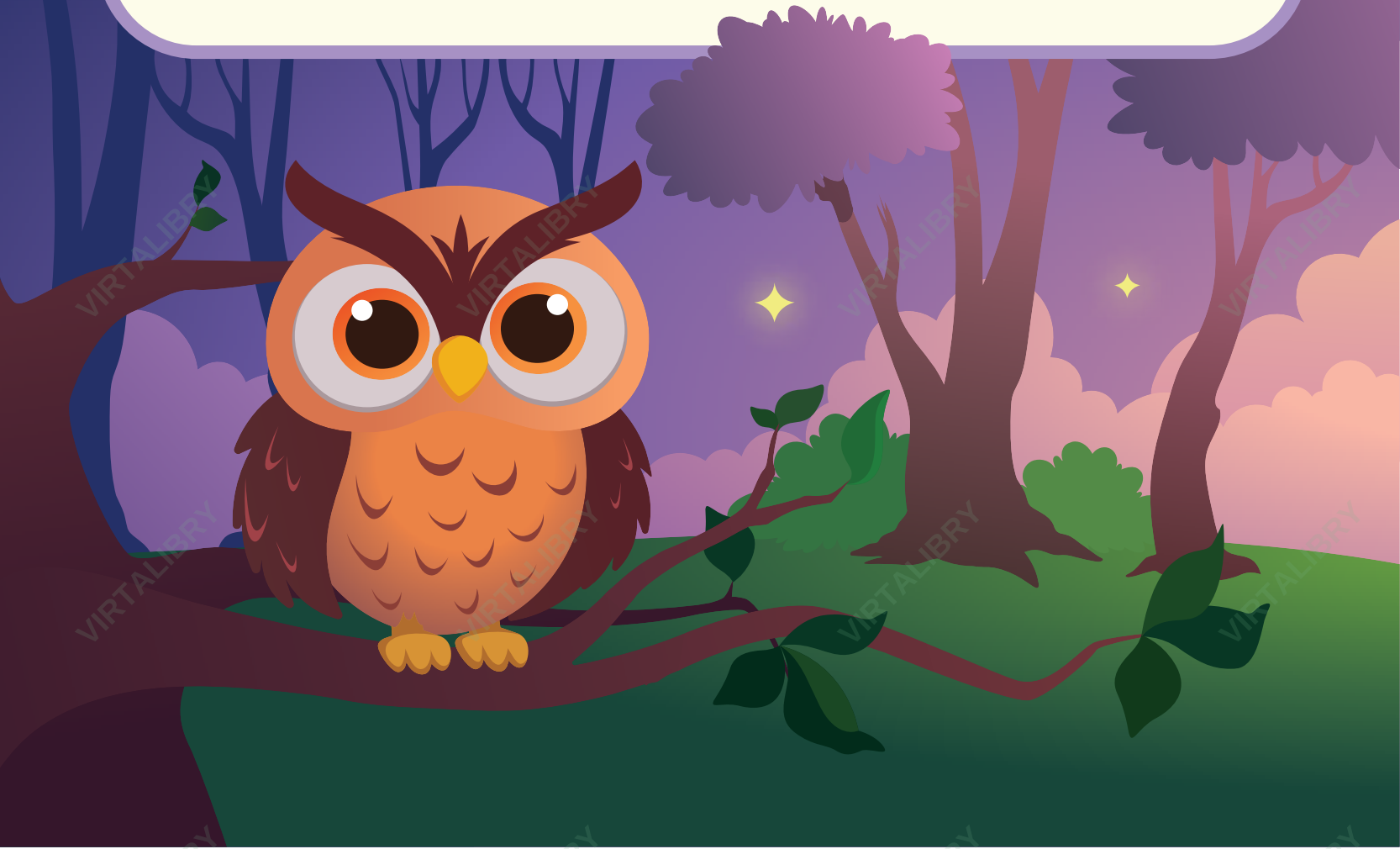


One starry night, as a gentle breeze danced through the leaves, Benny's grandpa noticed his sadness.

# Danny Deer Finds His Bravery



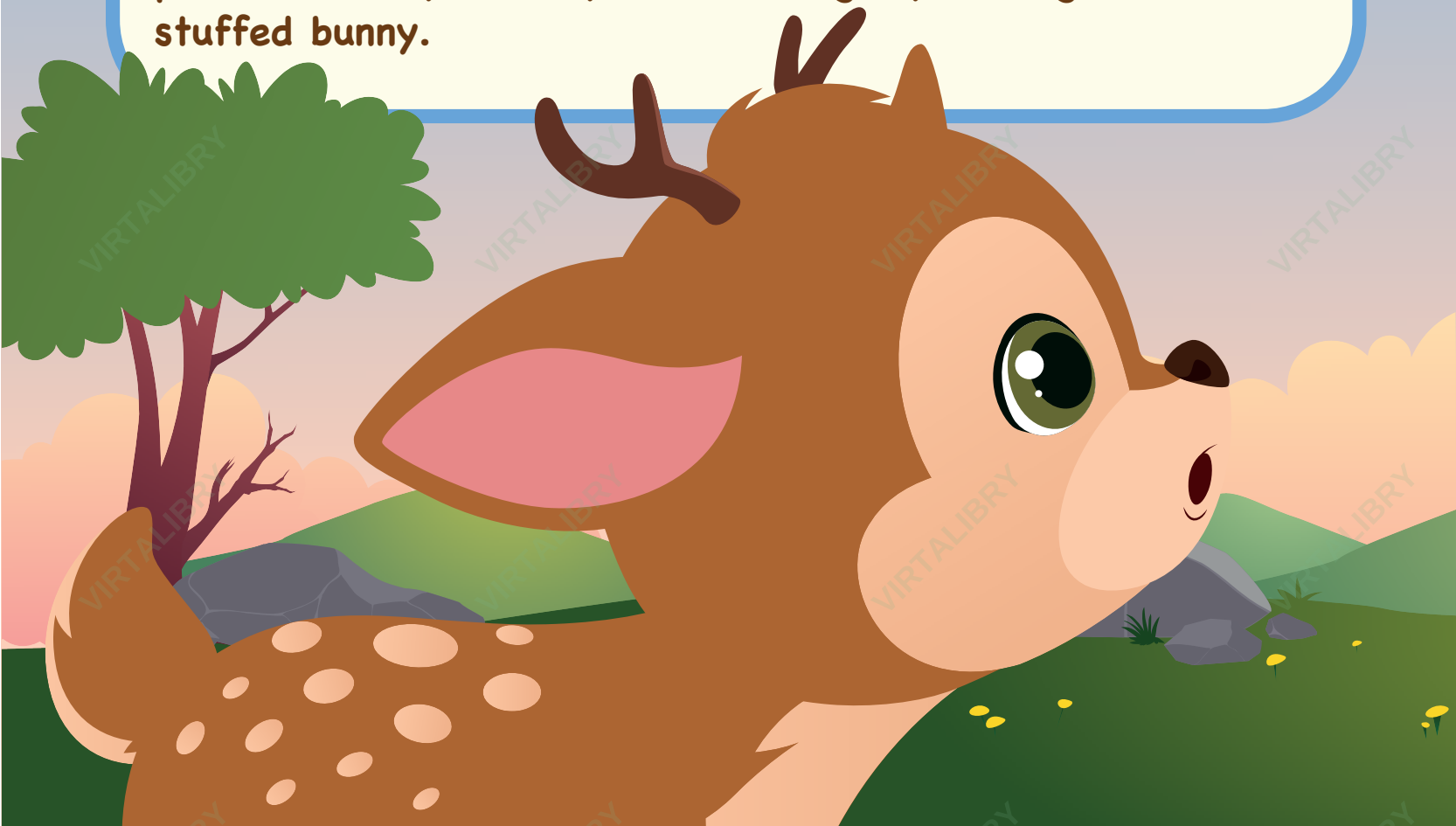

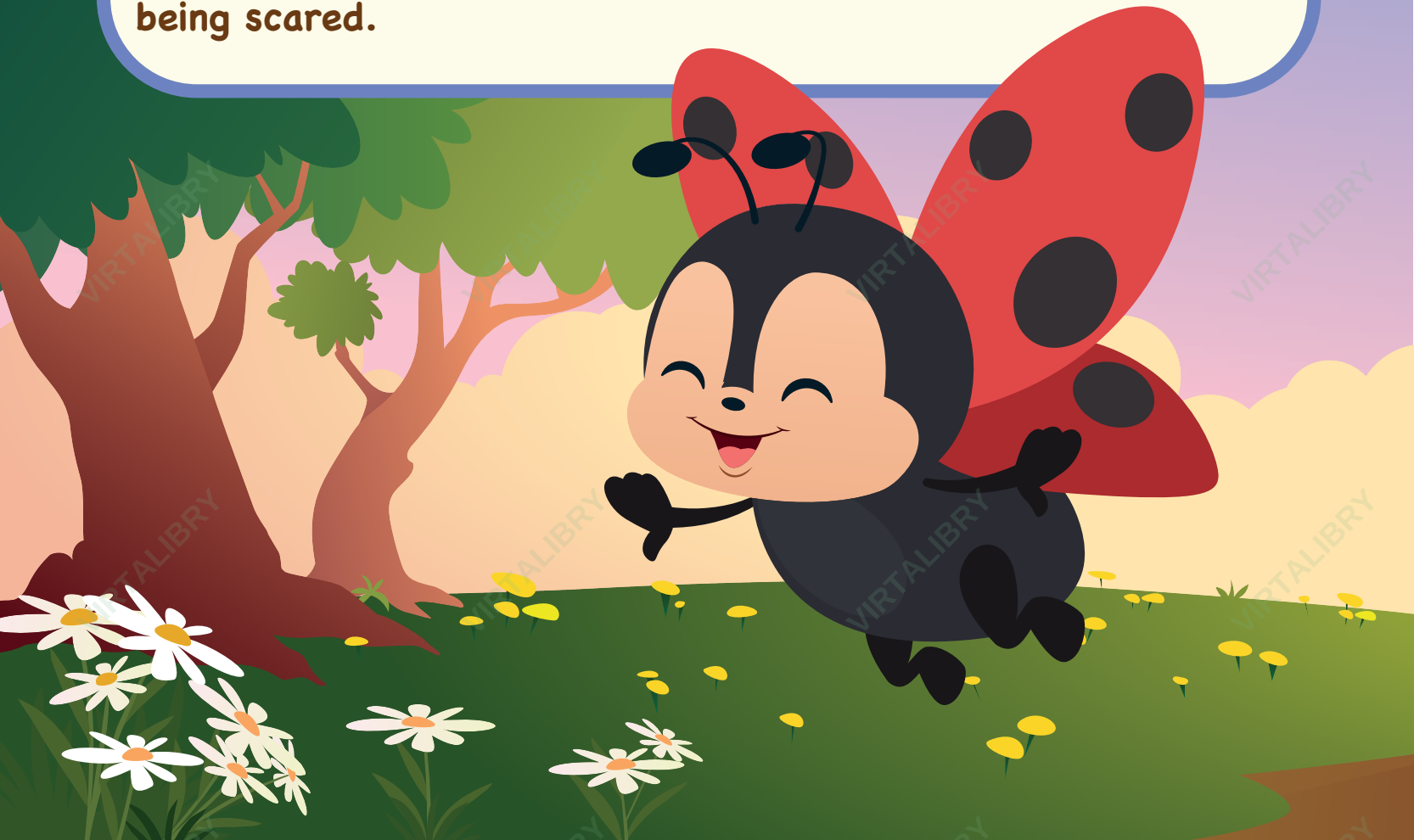
